COMMONS' APPROVAL FOR ANGLIO-ITALIAN PACT

Bitter Attacks by Labour and Liberal Speakers

"SURRENDER" SAYS L. G.

"THE FIRST STEP TOWARDS A HEALTHIER STATE OF THINGS IN EUROPE" WAS HOW MR. KEVILLE CHAMBERLAIN DESCRIBED THE ANGLIO-ITALIAN AGREEMENT IN THE HOUSE OF COMMONS DEBATE ON MONDAY NIGHT ON HIS MOTION APPROVING THE AGREEMENT.

Mr. Lloyd George described the Agreement as a dishonourable surrender, and Mr. Attlee said that Mr. Chamberlain's premiership had been a year of unparalleled humiliation for the country.

The Under-Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs would open the debate for the Government and claimed that the Premier's policy had been eminently successful, instating the agreements with Eire and Italy, and the trade talks with America. The approval motion was carried by 316 to 100.

The Labour amendment opposing the Government motion approving the Anglo-Italian Agreement was rejected by the House of Commons last night by 322 votes to 111 after a long debate. The amendment required that no agreement should be made without the approval of the House of Commons. Mr. Chamberlain referred to the letter which had been received from Great Britain and Italy during the last few years and said that when he succeeded Mr. Baldwin the situation rapidly was becoming acute. The Agreement was the result of efforts made which had been undertaken in the past few years and which he considered to be a healthy state of things. 

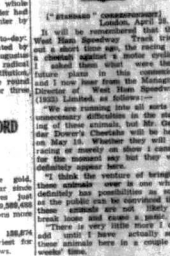

British Cotton "Drive" urged for Eastern Africa

British trade in East Africa received the major portion of members' attention at to-day's meeting of the East African Section of the London Chamber of Commerce, held at the Chamber's premises in Cannon Street under the chairmanship of Major Sir Humphrey Leggett, D.S.O. After Sir Harold MacMillan's statement in London, in which he said he did not think British traders were showing enough initiative in pushing British goods in native districts, the Section circulated a memorandum embodying its views, and various suggestions had been received in reply.

A communication from Tanganyika expressed the view that it was incorrect to presuppose that the natives were not spending their incomes, and it is understood that the question is being looked into from this angle. Investigations made into native purchasing power in the Lake Provinces showed that economic conditions were satisfactory in various districts. Last year could not be regarded as a particularly bad one before average, the sale of produce for the total of £22,000,000, £43,000,000 in 1956. This latter fact the Chairman, bore out the information on which the Governor of Tanganyika made his remarks in London last July.

The Native had every article brought to him for sale. Weekly markets with his wants and approval. He was purchasing articles which would have been impossible to obtain a few years ago, and it could not be regarded as accurate that the natives were not prepared to purchase goods.

Japanese Imports
Mr. Corderford (Keyser, Son and Co. Ltd.) said that from information on the spot, warehouses were full of Japanese goods imported last year which had not gone into consumption.

Major Dale (H. M. Eastern Africa Dependencies Trade and Information Office) suggested that this did not mean that the trade in Japanese goods had been so hot that they had been over-imported.

The Chairman said he understood there was a heavy carry-over of goods which could be put into marketing power. One of Sir Harold MacMillan's points had been spending their money they were hoarding it. He thought a good deal of it was hoarding power would be carried over into 1956.

Major Walsh thought the Government's observations were to blame for this Japanese importation. Facilities accorded to other traders were granted to the Japanese.

DICTATORS TALK ABOUT CZECHS

Duce Ready to Support Anglo-French Efforts?

The talk between Signor Mussolini and Herr Hitler on Wednesday lasted for 40 minutes. The subjects were not disclosed but officials on both sides said afterwards that no weaker of the Berlin-Rome axis was revealed. German circles do not admit that the Sudeten problem in Czechoslovakia was discussed, except purely in a consultative sense, and declare that the intention should remain any country other than Czechoslovakia and Germany.

It is believed however that Signor Mussolini, while eventually prepared to adopt a policy of neutrality towards a moderate Frenchman, will lead his diplomatic support to Britain and France in their attempt to arrange a modus vivendi which will solve the crisis.

London Opera Sensation

London, May 4. There was unusual interest at Covent Garden Opera House last night. The first dance, Miss Little Lehmann's madrigal staged in the midst of a new "Honey Bee" and, retired from the stage. An appeal was then made to an opera singer known to be in the audience and she was invited to sing and continued the performance.

Lords and Coal Royalties

Nightly, May 3. In a further debate on the Coal Bill in the House of Lords last night, the Lord Chancellor defended the bill, stating compensation for mining royalties would be granted. He considered that the compensation to the miners was fair and reasonable and said that the coal royalties had been dealt on the same basis as other royalties. The interested parties must accept this compensation on the basis of 15 per cent. per annum for a waiting period of 10 years.

DERBYSHIRE MOOR BLAZE

London, May 4. The biggest blaze ever seen in the Forest of Dean Derbyshire moorland broke out on White Ridge Moor yesterday afternoon, and it was still burning this morning. More than three thousand sheep were saved but many were burnt.

NON-INTERVENTION MEETING SO?

Rugby, May 3. The French Ambassador in London, Monsieur Corbin, called at the Foreign Office last evening and issued a note on behalf of his Government on certain aspects of matters which have recently been under discussion by the powers party to the intervention in Spain. Agreement to be announced by the Secretary of State for War will be given in the near future. Considerable attention and consideration will be given to the note. It is understood and anticipated that the note will be discussed by the Non-Intervention Committee and the British Official Wireless Service.

FRENCH LINER GUTTED

Lafayette Ablaze In Dock at Le Havre

Paris, May 4. A disastrous fire broke out about midnight last night on the French liner Lafayette in dry dock at Le Havre. The fire was caused by a gas leak and the ship was completely gutted out. The fire broke out while an engine was being started and the boiler furnace and quickly spread to the oil tanks, which were full of fuel. Fire brigades from a large area were called to the scene.

America May Allow Arms To Spain

New York, May 4. The United States Government is reported to be in favour of selling arms to Spain. The State Department is said to be studying the matter and it is expected that a decision will be reached in the near future. The necessary legislation is said to be being prepared for the Congress.

90 Arrests in Jamaica

Kingston, Jamaica, May 4. The sugar plantations in Jamaica were closed for a few days last night, but arrests are still being made and the fulfilment of the sugar industry is now under way. The Government announced to-day that it has taken steps to deal with the problem of unemployment. (Reuter).

London, May 4. In the course of a debate in the House of Lords last night reference was made to the apathy of the public towards election and Government. The Lord Chancellor stated that the Government was determined to do its best to secure a fair and free election.

It is stated that the Chinese are able to call on very large reserve forces and that 600,000 troops are standing by ready for service. The Japanese are said to be in a very difficult position and it is expected that they will be driven from the area.

Britain and U.S. Agree to French Plan

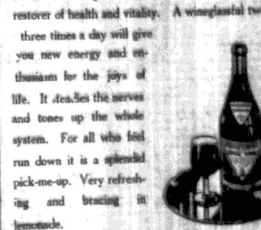

Demand for no Further Delay in Implementing the Kenya Land Commission Report

GOVERNMENT'S QUALIFIED ACCEPTANCE

IN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ON FRIDAY LAST MOTION BY MAJOR CAVENDISH-BENTON ON THE CARRYING OUT OF THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE CARTER LAND COMMISSION WAS PASSED, ONLY THE INDIAN MEMBERS VOTING AGAINST.

The debate was marked by two outstanding speeches, the first by the acting Commissioner for Local Government Lands and Settlement (Hon. C. E. The debate was resumed on Friday morning on the motion by the Member for Nairobi North, Major Cavendish-Benton, M.P., that "That if the objective of the Kenya Land Commission is to be achieved and the existing conditions of land in Kenya to be improved, the Commission should be empowered to carry out a survey of the land in Kenya and to report thereon to the Secretary of State and to the Governor."

Government's qualified acceptance of the motion was announced by the Commissioner for Local Government Lands and Settlement, Major C. E. Harrier, M.B.E., at the beginning of a 40-minute debate in which the motion was carried by a large majority. 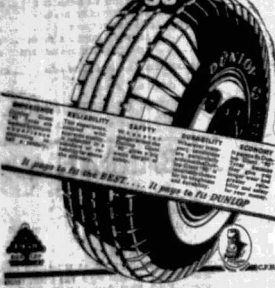

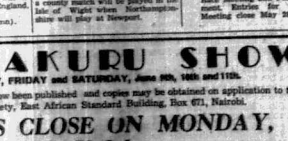
