

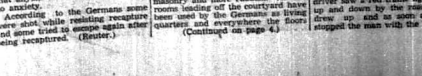
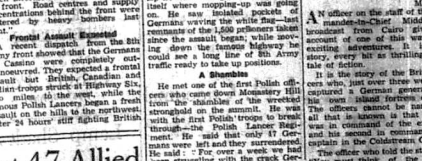

MUCH discussion is taking place in Kenya and elsewhere regarding the fertility of the soil, and whether or not the soil is being robbed owing to increased cropping.

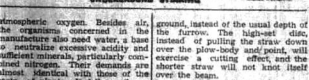
