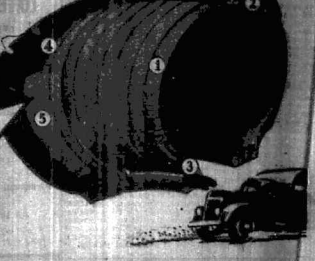

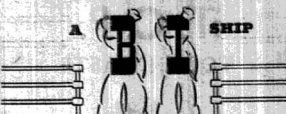

**POTATOES FOR
SEED SETS**

To obtain the best results, seed potatoes should be set as near 20 cwt. as possible, but when there is a shortage of seed, as at present, it may be necessary to use larger potatoes and cut them, but never more than 2 or 3 in weight, allowing one or two good eyes in each piece. It is recommended that cutting be done under shelter every day, and that the cut sets be kept under damp conditions for at least 48 hours and thereafter under cool steady conditions until time for planting arrives. With many potatoes cutting may be done 15 days before planting. Damp conditions suitable for the first 48 hours after cutting may be obtained in many ways, the sets can be laid thinly in boxes and be covered with damp earth or a layer of the soil, but may be watered. Spraying of sets should be avoided.

In practice, when tubers are cut and they are always cut longitudinally in such a way that other half has a strong apical shoot. With very large tubers will be provided with eyes each half may again be divided into two parts.

The following paragraph from "Potato Varieties" by Ballman expressed in a scientific manner why the above treatment should be especially carried out—

"Primarily and Johnson have shown that success with the use of cut sets depends very largely on the immediate treatment to which the cut tubers are subjected. A cut tuber is obviously deprived of the protection over a large area of its surface which the intact skin affords and this renders it more liable to infection than also against fungal attack. Thus, every large tuber will be provided with eyes each half may again be divided into two parts.

When the surface has been temporarily sealed by this deposit, the cortical cells below divide, thus walls become suberized and a layer of cork cells, similar to that which makes up most of the skin, covers the cut surface. The deposit of the suberized is both encouraged and hastened by keeping the cut tuber in a moist atmosphere away from the light for from twenty-four to forty-eight hours. On the other hand, exposure to a dry atmosphere and to the sunlight inhibits the formation of suberin more or less completely so that it is found in scattered fibres rather than as a continuous covering on the raw surface. The corky film which subsequently appears follows the patchy distribution of the suberin and as a consequence the tuber set is not very impervious to infection and falls an easy prey to fungal attack."

They are more stringent than those in force in other parts of Kenya and in fact represent the regulations which were first brought out in the Colony, and which were subsequently revised in the case of the Municipality of Mombasa. The new regulations, "an opaque cardboard disc shall be fitted immediately behind the glass of each headlamp and shall cover the whole area of the glass except for an aperture of a circular shape whose diameter shall be the same as the diameter of the lamp. The cover shall be completely blacked out with black cardboard or paper or with two coats of matt black paint up to a distance of half an inch above the centre line of the reflector."

"Provided that, instead of an opaque cardboard disc being fitted behind the glass of each headlamp, each headlamp may be fitted with a circular mesh iron net in diameter projecting not less than three inches from the front of the lamp, or constructed so that light is not cut except through three horizontal parallel apertures at the front and rear thereof not exceeding four inches in length and not exceeding two-thirds of an inch in width; such apertures shall not be less than two-thirds of an inch apart and the apertures shall be fitted on the upper edge of the net with a narrow strip of mesh two-thirds of an inch in width. The mesh shall be fitted with both plates so shown, but no mesh or light is emitted from the lamp above the horizontal line and with a ground or obscure glass screen at the rear thereof."

"Provided further that, in the case of a headlamp which provides illumination by means other than by a filament, instead of an opaque cardboard disc being fitted behind the glass of the lamp, such lamp shall be covered by a sufficient number of coats of paint to make a glass opaque."

FOREIGN CURRENCIES AND SECURITIES

Finance Regulations And Restrictions

The attention of the public is invited to two Government Notices Nos. 10 and 112 under the Defence (Finance) Regulations, 1945, which appear in this week's issue of the Official Gazette, the one relating to controlled foreign currencies and the other being the Securities, Depositories and Returns (Amendment) Regulations, 1945.

Regulation 7 of the Defence (Finance) Regulations, 1945, requires that every person resident in the Colony who is entitled to sell, or to procure the sale of, any foreign currency to which the regulation applies, shall forthwith offer it, or cause it to be offered, for sale at such price as may be determined by or on behalf of the Governor. The National Bank of India, Ltd., the Standard Bank of South Africa, Ltd., and the Bank of East Africa, Ltd., which have been designated by the Governor for this purpose, each persons may also transfer to one of these banks any right to assign, or to procure the assignment of, any right to receive outside East Africa a payment in any of the currencies specified. The regulations apply, inter alia, to payment for exports and to payment of the interest on commission in respect of imports into the Colony.

Application for Exemption

Any person who desires exemption from these provisions must apply for such exemption through one of the banks named and in the absence of specific exemption, failure to offer the currency or to assign the right, as the case may be, to a bank constitutes an offence. The rates at which foreign currency will be purchased may be obtained by application to any bank, and all persons who are in doubt as to their liability under this regulation are advised to consult their bank immediately in order to avoid legal proceedings.

The foreign currency to which this regulation applies is such foreign currency as may from time to time be designated by the Governor for the purposes of the regulations by notice published in the Gazette and in the Official Government Notice No. 282 is to cancel the previous list of such foreign currencies and substitute the following:—Argentine, Canadian dollars, Ecuador, Netherlands East Indies guilders, Netherlands West Indies guilders, New Zealand dollars, Panamanian dollars, Philippine pesos, Swedish kronor, Swiss francs, United States dollars, and other securities.

DATES FOR MANGROVE POLES

Suggestion For Preservation Of Lamu Industry

RECIPROCAL TRADE ADVANTAGES

By Government I might quote the recent action of the Home Government in buying up the output of steel in Great Britain. The date must not be sent here in steamers. Not merely because of the high cost of shipping freight and the imperative need to reserve steel for the manufacture of essential supplies, but chiefly because it is a first step to the securing of the output of the proposal, which is to increase the flow of steel to Lamu and then to lead them up for their return journey with our mangrove poles and other produce.

Last Post of Gal

So far as Lamu exports to the Persian Gulf are concerned, the mangrove poles are by far and away the principal item and the value of last year's exports was £3,397. There were also other miscellaneous items such as cotton, sisal, tanned skins, hides, and the value of £8,654, but the most interesting source of income from these foreign goods has been the woolsey output in the form of their crews.

Lamu is a favourite port of call with these sailormen and provides them with their last days before setting out on the long transoceanic voyage back to their homes. This being so, any mangrove-pole maker entry in the town which has been found leading the poles to other round making producers of waders for the sale at home. Captain Vincent, holder of the Lamu permit, says that he has a few poles to spare, but that he is not making any money and, at present, has no stock of poles on hand and contains little in Lamu stockpiles. I want that the average crew of the 23 larger-drove ships then in harbour was 25 men per dhow, with a crew of 300 in each of such of these took an average of 250 tons of goods to the town, and which will be an additional load on the dhow's crew.

To sum up, the advantages of the proposal are (1) our troops and other personnel who are engaged in the supply of an excellent foodstuff of good keeping quality; (2) the moral and economic benefits to be derived to the country; (3) relief will be afforded to an important industry that at present is seriously threatened; and (4) our relations with our Arab and Persian friends and allies will be further strengthened and improved.

Appealing and Nutrition


Dishes form a very appealing and nutritious food appealing to people of all ages, climates, and nationalities. These would be appreciated by all white troops, as well as by the natives. The health of a soldier is also an issue on a liberal scale.

Let our authorities get at once into touch with British representatives in the date producing and shipping areas and get out orders for export contracts for the delivery of 400,000 lbs of dates in the area in Kenya. There need be no better than about ordering supplies to be made up to last until the next season's date harvest starts, and shipping steady means of storage, or by putting them in cold stores which will keep good for indefinite periods. The reason why something must be done about it as once is that the dhow will be beyond their home ports, after which the opportunity will be lost to buy it at a price which will be no better than the price it will be at once by other means.

Making a Friendly Market

Inducement being offered in this way the dhow will come and when they have been paid for the dates will be in funds wherever to buy the mangrove poles they so much need, but which, without some co-operation, they would otherwise be unable to buy at a price which would be remembered, too, that these date groves are also growing in the other parts of the country. It may be said that the money paid will not be as good as that of the purchase of the poles. As a precedent for such operations

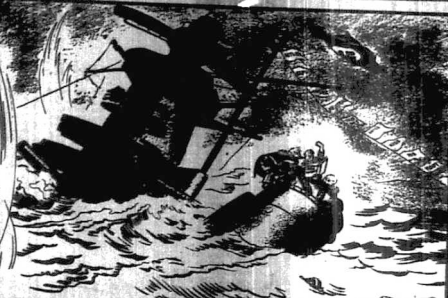

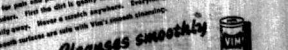

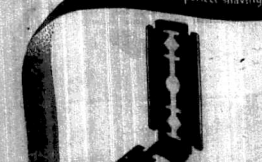
