# SNATCHED Into SPACE?

**HERE** Mr. Jessup introduces a series of slides, which we shall start publishing next week. He demands that we "let our imaginations fly," and he proposes to be shaken to the foundations of our beliefs.

From deep research, Mr. Jessup concludes that flying saucers are not mere "mystery machines" or "produced" objects, but are objects which have been in existence for over 2,000 years.

In this century, controversial aerial developments are even more remarkable. He has accumulated dozens of historical references and now accepts that the winged folk's notion—that people on earth had been kidnapped and swept away into outer space—is incorrect.

It was on June 24, 1917, that many people still imagine—flying saucers were born. A businessman of Boise, Idaho, Mr. Kenneth Arnold was on his way from Chehalis to Yakima, Washington. Flying in his private plane he saw a bright flash on his wing.

Looking to the direction of Mount Rainier he was astonished to see something like the tail of a Comet flying close by. Mr. Arnold was very nervous. As he later told the story "it was as if they were talking to me. They flew close to the top of the mountain in a diagonal, chiraline line."

Mr. Arnold estimated their speed to be around 1,200 miles per hour, and he thought they must have been about 35 to 50 miles from the plane.

"I watched them about three minutes," he said, "before they were swerving in and out around the high mountain peaks. They were fast, like a plane, and so noisy they reminded me of the a minor. I never saw anything as fast."

# SOLDIERS NOT GUILTY OF KIPSIGIS MURDER

## Leave court 'without a stain'

AFTER retiring for 75 minutes, a jury in Nairobi yesterday found Sgt. Alfred Edmund Fombek (24) and five other soldiers not guilty of murdering a Kipsigis herdsman and not guilty of any lesser offence. The High Court public galleries were crowded when the verdict was announced.

"You have had a fair trial and you have been acquitted by 12 of your own countrymen. You leave this court without a stain on your characters," Justice de Bussche told the two men. Sgt. Fombek, in dark green uniform, and five other soldiers, both saluted the judge before leaving the court.

### Summing-up

The judge summed up for more than 45 minutes. He thought the jury should find the two accused innocent.

"I find the two accused innocent of the killing of the man and did they kill him in the prosecution of their duty?"

"If the prisoner was killed while attempting to escape, was it necessary to shoot him in order to apprehend him or to prevent his escape?"

"Did the man who was killed in self-defence by the soldier?"

"The same would apply to Sgt. Fombek, because he would be entitled to defend his men if he thought that man was being attacked."

### Jury recalled

The jury retired at 12.45 p.m. but returned to the courtroom after ten minutes to hear the judge's summing-up.

One point raised to evidence which the judge said indicated that Sgt. Fombek had acted lawfully in the shooting was the second witness's report that the man was shot after two seconds immediately after the shooting.

All those who saw the man after the shooting had said they thought he was "coming back with themselves" at having done something they thought was good. "A normal person, you might think, would be upset and nervous after committing a murder," the judge pointed out.

### Help in Emergency

Mr. C. S. Tompkins (Acting Director, Public Prosecution) told the jury in his final address that the fact the two accused had helped Kenya to its independence was not a stain on their records.

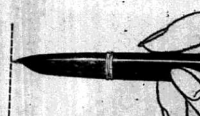

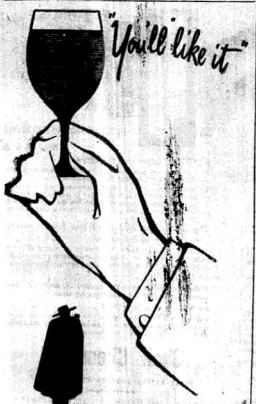

The law which brought it into being laid the foundation for a new pattern of land management in the United States where the national parks are set aside for the people's use and enjoyment.

In 1849 an Act of Congress established the National Park Service. The Act was signed by President Polk and provided for the protection and preservation of the natural resources of the United States. It was the first step in the development of the national parks system.

The Grand Canyon in Arizona, Yellowstone in Wyoming, and Sequoia in California are some of the most famous of these parks. Each year millions of Americans visit these parks to enjoy the natural beauty of the country. The National Park Service is the agency responsible for the management and maintenance of these parks.
