KIKUYU POTTERY OFF TO A GOOD START

Kangemi extension planned

Kenya's newest pottery works at Kangemi, near Nairobi, which produces good quality earthenware for export, was visited by some of the 160 delegates who attended the Teaching Conference at the Royal Technical College this week. They met Mrs. Aliceen Belcher, pottery project officer for the Department of Community Development and Rehabilitation, and Mr. Arthur Walcott, Registrar of Co-operative Societies.

Mrs. Belcher has been happy to see the extension of the pottery project to the Kangemi pottery works, which opened in 1932 with the intention of mass-producing fewer and of better quality earthenware goods for sale locally.

Under the guidance and leadership of Mrs. Belcher, 37 Kilima women from the Kangemi area of Nairobi district had earned lower-cost pottery products for their own use and had become co-operators in the pottery project. They were destined for both the local market and for export to a fair price.

Society formed

The women of Kangemi village had organized themselves into a co-operative society of 37 members, which was formed at the end of last year. The women are co-operatively registered under the Co-operative Societies Ordinance.

Land of the main Kangemi pottery works is available to the co-operative by the women of Kangemi. Funds collected from the sale of their pottery products are used to pay for electricity and other expenses.

The Industrial Co-operative Society is working with the co-operative to produce a wide range of earthenware, bowls and other articles for the local market. The women are also producing earthenware for export to other parts of Kenya.

Boys dies in water-hole

African workmen made up a water-hole in a road near Nairobi, which was used for watering their animals. The water-hole was made in a deep gully, and the water was drawn from a well. A boy named John Mwangi, aged 12, fell into the water-hole and drowned.

ONE RIVAL PRESIDENT OFFERS TO RESIGN

Appeal for tax relief to encourage new capital

THE president of the Uganda Mining Association, Mr. D. V. Broadhead-Williams, warned members of the East African Commission on Income Tax yesterday that a "considerable loss" was being incurred by mining companies in Uganda, sections prospecting in the country.

Refugees Find Kindness And Opportunity In Displaced Persons Camp

A refugee camp set up near Hartford under the auspices of the World Council of Churches is taking in displaced persons from Eastern Europe, according to live-wire dispatches.

After trucking from camp in search of permanent homes, 1,500 Hungarians, Rumanians, Estonians, and other refugees are now many of them for the first time, finding kindness and the opportunity to do a useful job together. It is not surprising that they are not merely waiting to be resettled in other countries, but are actually settling in the United States.

At the British camp of West Hartford, where the refugees are housed, the World Council of Churches is providing them with food, clothing, and other necessities. Many suffer from lack of medical attention.

NEW CLINIC OPENED

The original idea for the camp was from the Protestant Church authorities, foremost of whom is the Rev. Dr. Charles M. Mayo, who is the pastor of the Hartford Y. W. C. A. Other institutions that are helping include the Lutheran World Federation, and British soldiers and their families stationed in the area.

GIANT JIGSAW PUZZLE FOR ARMY Royal Engineers Help Make

SEVERAL survivors of the 19 Field Survey Company, Royal Engineers, who were captured in the mountains of East Africa, are now working on a giant jigsaw puzzle to piece together the map of the area before them at the moment.

The puzzle, which is the largest ever made, is made up of 100,000 pieces of paper, each of which is a square of the map. The puzzle is being worked on by the survivors of the 19 Field Survey Company, Royal Engineers, who were captured in the mountains of East Africa, and are now working on a giant jigsaw puzzle to piece together the map of the area before them at the moment.

Military Maps

The Royal Engineers are co-operating with the Survey of Kenya and Government Printers, Nairobi, on the healthy process of map-making. The project is being supervised by CPT. T. W. MURPHY, at present the work done by the Engineers on military maps of Kenya.

Map terrorists and wild game, survey teams usually find few survivors in the remote areas. Last year one survivor was killed and two were injured by terrorists.

First the soldier survivors must reconstruct the area and select outstanding hills to use as triangulation points. They measure the angles between these points with a theodolite, a strictly scientific instrument, and its readings are plotted on a map. The triangulation marks for observations may be in the form of a theodolite, an electric lamp or a wooden beacon.

Mirror reflects

sun's rays

In East Africa the theodolite, a mirror which reflects the sun's rays — is preferred, more of course. A really large theodolite can be seen from 100 miles away. They are vulnerable to damage by wild game or theft by natives, whilst electric lamps require a portable engine set to keep their batteries at working temperature. However, even in East Africa theodolites are always ready to hand and must be kept in the best possible condition.

JEAN VAUGHAN VISITS THE— Largest Government Girls' School In East Africa

The largest Government girls' school in East Africa occupies an impressive block of buildings set well back behind playing fields and gardens, from Giza Road Gloucester School, originally opened in 1911, as the Government Indian Girls' School, in buildings in Government Road.

The new buildings were occupied at the beginning of 1956. The main block faces the road, and consists of administrative offices near the entrance and clock tower in the centre, while on either side and on both floors, extend long corridors of classrooms. Behind the clock tower, and at right angles to the main block, is a fine school hall connecting with a single-storey block of science classrooms, parallel to the main building. The hall thus forms the cross-bar of a rough H in the ground plan.

In May, 1955, the name of the school was changed to the Duchess of Gloucester School, and the Duchess sent a photograph of herself and a letter of good wishes to the school. The girls are encouraged to help in the maintenance of the school. They are members of the Royal Air Force Cadets. Another class of girls is given practical lessons in the class which has been set up for them. The room has been supplied with fresh flowers.

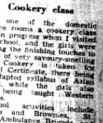
