£70,000 needed to improve lake transport facilities

£350,000 OVER TARGET FOR CEREALS BILLS

THE Kenya Cereals Finance Corporation's latest offer of £350,000 for the improvement of lake transport facilities on Lake Albert and Lake Edward was received by the Government yesterday. The average rate of interest on the £350,000 loan is 2 1/2% per cent, and the amount of the loan is £250,000 less £50,000 for the purchase of motor launch equipment for the three larger lakes operating on Lake Edward.

Mr. D. H. Roberts, secretary of the Kenya Finance Corporation, said yesterday that this was the largest amount of money ever offered for the improvement of lake transport facilities in Kenya. He said that the offer had been well received and that the Government would be asked to consider the offer by the end of the month.

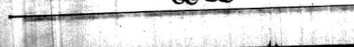

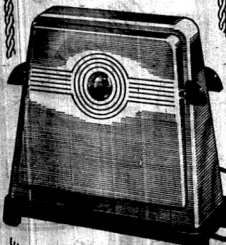

Tsavo slaughter by poachers

POISONED ARROWS AND WIRE NOOSES USED

INFORMATION which pointed to the "disastrous and extensive activities" of African poachers in the Tsavo National Park has been brought back by a patrol, which in a distance of a few miles has slain 39 dead elephants and many dead buffaloes.

Mr. M. Cowie, Director of the Royal National Parks of Kenya, made this known this week in an interview with the East African Standard. "In the small space of a few square miles, more than 39 rhino carcasses were found by the park along the Gidiga River in the vicinity of its junction with the Mita-Akabet River."

"Along the banks of the river the numerous carcasses of one elephant, rhino, buffalo, giraffe, zebu and various antelope species, rhino were clearly evident and had been shot with poisoned arrows. These animals had been shot by poachers," Mr. Cowie said.

"The poacher had been recognized and had been seen to be carrying off and there were marks of poisoned arrow. It is perfectly clear that about all areas where rhinos are in the region are being hunted by poachers. It is a matter of time before the animals will be exterminated."

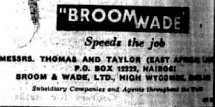

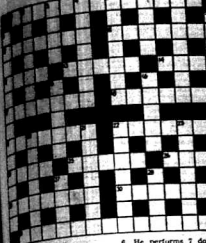

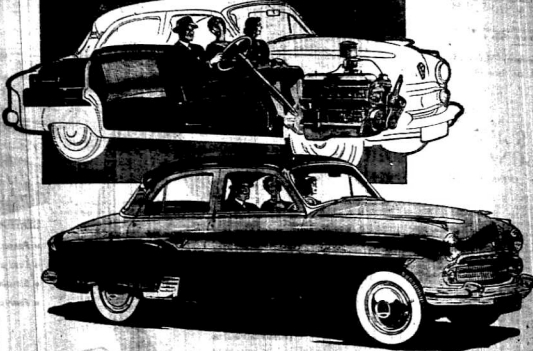
