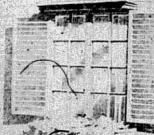

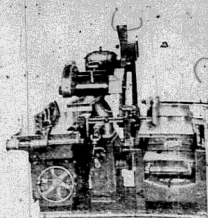

Draft Bill includes UK rulings

A draft Bill to amend the Traffic Act 1930 and to give effect to the provisions of the United Kingdom Traffic Act 1930, as amended, is being introduced into the House of Representatives.

Republicans win in heavy polling

MR DWIGHT EISENHOWER, Republican, has been elected the first President of the United States since the death of Mr. Franklin D. Roosevelt in 1945. Mr. Eisenhower was elected in a heavy polling by the Republicans, who won a majority of 308 votes in the electoral college.

The election was held on Tuesday, November 3, 1953. Mr. Eisenhower, a former general in the United States Army, defeated Mr. Adlai Stevenson, a Democrat, who was the incumbent Vice-President.

Kenya butter exports rise price lower than local

EXPORTS of Kenya butter for the year ended June 30, 1963, were nearly one and a half times as much as in the annual report of Kenya Co-operative Creameries. Total output of butter rose from 1,447,000 lbs. in 1962 to 2,100,000 lbs. in 1963. The total 2,500,000 lbs. was exported, half of it to the United Kingdom, representing a 24 per cent increase in overseas sales on the previous year. At the same time, the total 14,000 cwt. of butter was produced in Kenya, a 10 per cent increase on the 12,700 cwt. of the previous year. 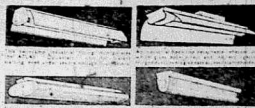

FOR the week ending last Wednesday, the average daily clearance for foreign cargo at Mombasa Port amounted to 1,122,394 lbs. for the week. This is a decrease of 10 per cent on the average daily clearance for the same period in 1962. The decrease is due to the fact that the 1962-63 season was a bumper one for the industry, and the 1963-64 season is expected to be even better.

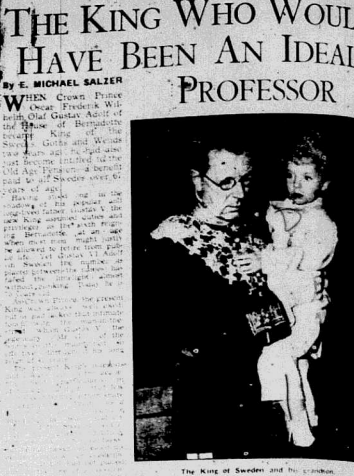

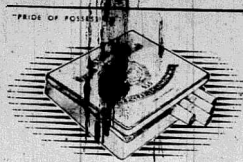
