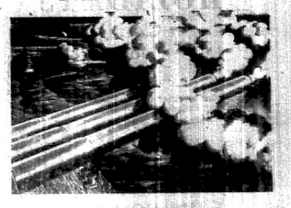

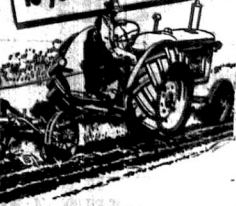

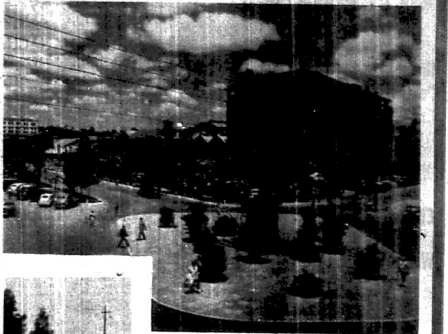

A MESSAGE FROM THE CHARTER MAYOR

"The credit for so much which we take pride in today belongs to men and women who are no longer with us, and the honour which is being conferred on Narobhi is one which reaches to the far corners of Kenya and to the farthest outposts of East Africa; for without the courage, initiative and effort of countless men and women, many of whom are and will for ever remain unknown, there could have been no East Africa, there could have been no Kenya and no Narobhi."

Turning point in the history of East Africa

WHEN it was first announced that His Majesty was to be petitioned to raise Narobhi to city status there was considerable speculation as to what was the true reason for the distinction.

Dr. E. Boedecker, well-known medical pioneer of Kenya, in a survey of the early days of the township, mentions that at Kabete in August, 1899 the original charter of the Municipal Corporation Library given unqualified support for Sergeant Ellis, of the Royal Engineers, who (he wrote) was indeed the first European to live in Narobhi.

Here is the relevant passage: "The Nairobi stream was beyond Allinworth Bridge, was inviolable and surrounded in a dense papaya swamp for several miles towards the Athi plains. The swamp afforded an ideal retreat for many an old lion with his mate and family to lie up in during the daytime after a successful night kill."

"The old caravan road crossed the stream on the north side about two miles below the bridge and led through the camping ground at the edge of the forest hills. Carefully enough in the old days at Fort Smith the Nairobi camp was never popular as it had few trees, regarded as an unhealthy locality, swarming with mosquitoes."

"Towards the end of 1896 the Uganda Government had established a transport depot near the safari camp. This depot was built by Sergeant Ellis, who was the first European to live in Narobhi."

He put up an excellent lot of substantial houses for accommodating stores, shops, etc. and also built a large and comfortable hotel for the transport men employed in transport work. The depot was eventually burnt in 1899 when railroads had reached the Eschschampsteden.

Narobhi's growth, Dr. Boedecker claimed, must be indisputably the result of the building of the Uganda Railway. The birth of Narobhi marked a turning point in a new chapter of history. Narobhi towards the end of the last century was virtually unknown to the Masses who on the high ground—now known as the Hill District—on the south side of the Nairobi forest.

These people grazed their herds of cattle over the open tract of the land adjoining the Nairobi forest. The site of the Nairobi forest was a favourite spot during the wet seasons and the lands of game were protected by the fertile land and grasslands around the cattle.

COUNCIL OF FIVE BEGIN TO PLAN

Almost with the birth of Narobhi foundations were laid to prevent the town growing haphazardly as these minutes of the 'inaugural' meeting of the town's councillors show.

The birth of local government in Narobhi dates back to April 18, 1900, when regulations made by Her Majesty's Commissioners and General under Article 42 of the East Africa Order-in-Council were published.

Called as the Nairobi Municipal Regulations" they applied to the area comprised within a radius of one mile and a half from the Nairobi Municipal Council office, which area, as any townships which were not proclaimed by the Nairobi Municipal Council.

In 1901, after demarcating all the land that is required for its own use, the Railway Department was the remaining area along the south side of the town, which together with the Government.

WHAT NAIROBI LOOKED LIKE IN 1911

J. A. WATSON, who was Town Clerk from 1911 to 1926, tells how the town left the pioneer stage.

In 1911, when I entered the service of Nairobi Municipality, the town was over ten years old. The early pioneering stage during which all the members of the small European community knew each other was over.

The residential area was a circle with a radius of 15 miles from the centre, the Town Hall, a three-story structure at the junction of Government Road and what is now Dalmeida Avenue.

Within this area there were over 60 miles of light roads, the only metalling was a narrow strip in the middle of Government Road, one mile from the railway station, a residential street except the P.M.B. by planting a banana tree every 100 yards, and the Government road shop, as a gesture of improvement.

Muddy morass
It was during the same years that a morass of complaints with Dutch wagers was reported to have been submitted, resulting in the slough which was the mud flats of the morass.

Some buildings were rare in Nairobi fewer still of more than one storey. The buildings were of wood, some of them of corrugated iron. The only high building was the Nairobi C.O.W. belonging to the Land Office, built by Sir Herbert Wright.

Every European kept his private carriage, drawn by his shamba boys, dressed in European dress. The roads were of mud, and were for all or even six inches a month.

Long range
In such circumstances, Nairobi had to live not only the pioneer stage, but also the pioneer stage of special problems peculiar to frontier towns and geographical isolation communities. (When at last it attained independence, it probably the most isolated corporation in the Empire, if not in the world.)

All these however could only be regarded as long-range problems and of the town had to be entirely dependent on a Government which was not untrammelled but expressed with affairs of considerably more than the parochial importance.
