



'Fly' at Sotik: Full-dress debate 'clears the air'

THE 'FLY' COMMISSIONER
THERE was a record attendance at a public meeting held at the Sotik Club on June 23 when the Member of Parliament for Nakuru (Major F. C. Cawthron) and the Director of Veterinary Services (Mr. J. E. Beaumont) were present. The object of the visit was to explore the tick-ticks position and the methods adopted by the Veterinary Department to combat the recent outbreak of trypanosomiasis.

The Hon. Mr. T. R. L. Preston (Member of Parliament for Nakuru) and Mr. Wilson, the Agent in Charge of the Veterinary Department, Dr. G. W. Williams, the Director of Veterinary Services, and Mr. Whittle, the Veterinary Officer in Charge of the Province, were present.

Dr. Beaumont, who gave a resume of the situation, said that the outbreak had been reported on the Nandi Hills and that the disease had spread to the Sotik area.

He said that the disease had been spreading rapidly and that the population of all herds in both areas had been infected.

He said that the disease might be controlled by the use of Atroxyl.

In the dry season ticks are found in the Nandi Hills and that they have been found in the Sotik area for 10 miles north of the town. He said that the ticks had increased in number and that the disease had spread to the Sotik area.

Dr. Beaumont said that the ticks had become accustomed to cattle.

Veterinary Department issued his repeated warning to farmers to keep their cattle away from the Sotik area for 10 years ago, Sotik could not withstand the disease.

In the present situation, Dr. Beaumont said for information after the use of Diamidone, which was a spray of piperazine, had been applied to the cattle, the ticks had been removed.



SISAL INDUSTRY COMPARED WITH GROUNDNUTS

M. R. F. HITCHCOCK, Chairman of the Tanganyika Sisal Growers' Association, told sixty-six growers and their 245 guests at the Agricultural Show dinner at the Royal Hotel that the industry may not have reached its peak, but it could easily reach equilibrium, the disparity being less than six weeks production.

At present in the economy of Tanganyika a million pounds sterling is spent annually on sisal, and other experts estimate that the figure will rise to £1 million by 1965.

One million dollars from E.C.A. to build African roads

HUNDREDS of miles of roads opening up isolated areas of Africa and South-East Asia, will be constructed with the help of Marshall Plan funds given to the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe by the United States.

Marshall Plan funds available through the Economic Commission for Europe will be used in road development projects in seven African territories.

They are the Gold Coast, Northern Rhodesia, Nigeria, Sierra Leone and Nyasaland in Africa; and North Korea, Thailand and Laos in South-East Asia.

The funds are coming from the Economic Commission for Europe to help the development of the continent.

Mr. John C. Egan, Director of the Economic Commission for Europe, said: "The Marshall Plan funds both for their own economic well-being and for their contribution to the welfare of Europe itself."

Mr. Egan said: "It will be made available from this same reserve fund which has been set aside for other development projects in the continent."

They are a reservoir construction and maintenance programme in the Gold Coast, Northern Rhodesia, Nigeria, Sierra Leone and Nyasaland.

Cyrus C. Egan, Director of the Economic Commission for Europe, said: "We have given about \$100 million to agricultural machinery for the island countries, and we expect that this will increase production of many crops."

ECA dollar debts in the road development projects will be repaid in 1965 in 21,000 dollars. In the Gold Coast, 10,000 dollars will be repaid in 1966, Nigeria 18,000 dollars, Northern Rhodesia 16,000 dollars, and Nyasaland 12,000 dollars.

Mr. Egan said: "This is the first time that the Economic Commission for Europe has given such a large amount of money to a single country."


