M.P.s DEMAND EXPULSION OF U.S. ENVOY

Second air-drop to free more Whites

For the immediate expulsion of the United States Ambassador to Kenya, Mr. Stovall, and the closure of the Embassy, were made in Nairobi yesterday by Kariuki. A statement by the chairman of the backbenchers' group, Mr. Wambui, also called for the expulsion of the backbenchers' group, and the suspension of their countries' passports 'aggression in the Congo'.

These demands by members of Kenya's ruling party came after a day marked by riotous demonstrations in Nairobi in which protests were directed against the American and Belgian Embassies and attempts were made to sack Diplomatic Corporation on fire. 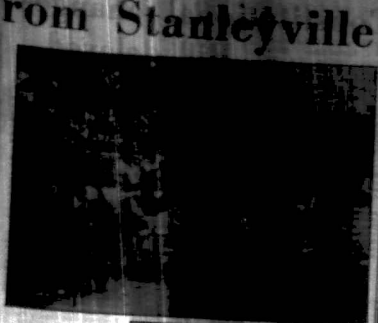

Flows from the horror that was Stanleyville, taken only hours after the Lumumba Movement massacre, these are the pictures that need explanation.

Green-faced soldiers transfer bodies of the victims to stretchers for transport out of the city. Refugees are marched into captivity by helicopter from traps... a rebel is ordered to kneel another reports out from interrogation before a threatening rifle butt... rebels are checked suspects await interrogation... and a moment of rest for troops before they go into action, for refugees before they leave the city.

Soon after getting these pictures on a plane bound for Nairobi, the photographer, Alexander South Dakota, of Alltoppi, was taken into custody by the Congolese Security. Late yesterday, a cable was received in Nairobi saying that he had been released and was safe.

KENYA'S DAIRY INDUSTRY SELLS TO 33 COUNTRIES

A six-fold rise in the price of Kenya's milk has led to the expansion of the industry. It is now one of the most important dairy industries in Africa. It provides practically all the dairy produce consumed in Kenya and exports over £10,000,000 worth of livestock every year.

Kenya's fruit and vegetable industry is represented at the exhibition by Kenya Canners Ltd., whose factory at Thika handles about 1,000 tons of fruit and 2,000 tons of vegetables a year.

The main vegetable exports are peas, French beans, green beans, tomatoes, cabbages, peas, carrots, and sweet potatoes.

Kenya's fruit exports include oranges, lemons, limes, guavas, mangoes, pineapples, and papayas.

The exhibition also has a special display for the local market. The produce is available in quantities of 100 lbs. or more.

Kenya's dairy products are sold to 33 countries in all. The main markets are in Europe, the Middle East, and South America.

The general manager of the K.C.C., Mr. Harold Phillips, has been elected chairman of the Kenya Dairy Board.

The industry's expansion over the past few years is shown by the following figures: In 1957 Kenya had 1,000,000 cows and 1,000,000 goats.

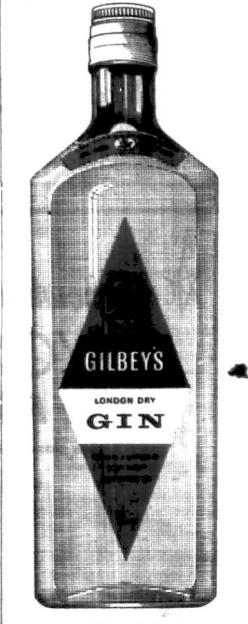

Premier to perform double opening for oil company

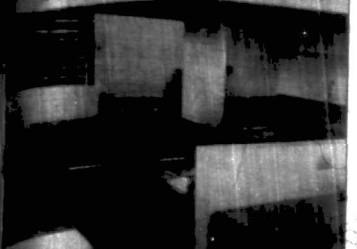
