



## MALAYSIA IN DRIVE FOR BIGGER CROPS

Malaysia's government has started a drive to make agriculture more efficient in the country. The first step is to increase production of rice and rubber, primarily a rubber and tin producer and a trading world's fourth largest tin producer.

The principal food import is rice, which is grown in a poor area.

Admiring the nation's efforts, the Federal Minister of Agriculture, Dr. Dato' Dr. S. J. Jais, said: "Our agriculture is in a state of stagnation in view of the rapid increase in population. The increasing concern of many people over the quality of our staple food is unacceptable and must be remedied by the introduction of modern methods of cultivation and by the use of modern equipment."

In the current situation, the government is determined to increase its output of rice and other crops to meet the growing demand for food.

## Exciting Christmas for Bernard in Britain

### JOHN ELGON'S FRIDAY MARY

A exciting Christmas has been arranged by the Nottingham Branch of the United Nations Children's Fund. Mr. John Elgon, who organized the project, which will help Bernard, who is suffering from leprosy. He has been brought to Britain by the Lord Mayor of Nottingham, Sir Alan Horsfall, the chairman of the Leprosy Research Fund, and the Lord Mayor of Birmingham, Sir Edward Williams, the chairman of the U.N.C.F. in the West Midlands.

The money will be used to

help Bernard get an operation.

At Southgate, London, Mr. Elgon, who has been working for the U.N.C.F. for 10 years, has arranged for a two-week course for Bernard, his mother and his brother, who are both blind. They will be taught to read Braille and to write in Braille.

The course will be given at the Kibera School, under the direction of Mr. J. C. Corlett, who has a British Council scholarship in the nation of Kenya. Mr. Corlett, who is originally from Kenya, will be assisted by a British teacher.

Bernard is at the Aman Centre, where he is learning to work at a technical school, near Nairobi, as a technical trainee.

Mr. Elgon, who is the son of Mr. and Mrs. William J. Elgon, of the British Council, arrangements were made for Bernard to go to the College of San Sebastian, at the Kibera School, under the direction of Mr. Corlett.

The College, Nairobi, Mr. F. M. Elgon, said, had agreed to take Bernard into its dormitory.

Mr. Elgon said that Bernard, who has a good sense of knowledge, was soon able to learn Braille and to read and write in Braille at Kibera. Like the C.I.T. College, Kibera has a Braille library and Braille books are available.

Mr. Elgon said that Bernard, who has been blind since birth, had been able to learn Braille and to read and write in Braille at Kibera.

Bernard is the victim of a hereditary disease, known as leprosy.
