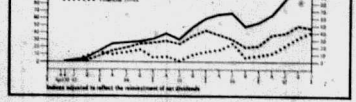

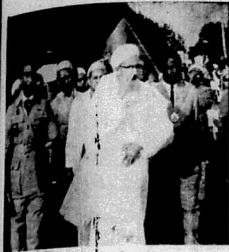

MASS VACCINATION IN UGANDA

Saving the children of Ankole

In Africa, as in many other parts of the developing world, the most critical years in a child's life is the period from five years old.

This age-group is crucial in the preschool child, although by no means all of the children in the developing countries have a chance of standing school in later years.

It is only comparatively recently that the preschool child, with whom within the World Health Organization a high content - has been made the subject of intensive care in some areas, mainly in the highlands of south-eastern Africa.

It has been estimated that more than 25 million children

in the Ankole District of Uganda are one year in Africa where this problem has already been studied in considerable detail, and the "p.p.p." or Preschool Protection Programme has yielded much valuable information since it was started in 1964 by Dr. Robert Cook, of the Pediatrics and Child Health Department of Makerere University Medical School.

Now the programme in Ankole has entered Phase Two, under the

direction of Dr. Cook's successor, Dr. W. M. M. M. Since 1964, the children of this 60,000-square mile district, stretching from Tansania to Rwanda in the south to the shores of Lake Edward, which forms the Congo border in the north-west, have been subjected not only to detailed examination from the medical and sociological points of view, they have also been immunized on a mass scale against common child diseases such as measles, mumps, whooping cough, tetanus, as well as against tuberculosis and smallpox.

This mass immunisation programme was undertaken in collaboration with the Uganda Government's Health Department, which has its own mobile immunisation teams in the Ankole District but has been the focus of the supply of the drugs, especially B.C.G. vaccine, which is especially difficult to transport, and the P.D.S. vaccine, which is especially difficult to transport.

Among the specialised equipment used in the programme, work, ideally suited to transport large numbers, have been the immunisation machines which force the vaccine under the skin with a high-pressure jet.

It is capable of vaccinating 1,000 people an hour and has been used with great success for administering triple vaccine against measles, mumps and whooping cough. It has been used for measles and B.C.G. vaccine intradermally. Similar vaccinations have been done by the conventional multiple pressure machine.

The Ankole operation has served as a model for the much larger but less intensive Campaign, launched by the Uganda Ministry of Health.

The Ankole District was chosen for the "p.p.p." project mainly because the people of the area were particularly amenable to the investigation and, right from the start, proved very cooperative. Some 100 miles distant from Kampala, Ankole lies across the Equator, just north of the shores of Lake Edward, and contains largely of open savannah country, used for cattle grazing although there are

patches of cultivation and also some forest.

Most people, at times, get an urge to explore and even if they find nothing, will enjoy the quiet of a secluded island.

A small family party went fishing and dropped the net at Crescent Island, a place I have always visited on my way to regular in after succeeding years, and now an island once again. It so happens this was one of the best.

The island, at a guess, is about 1/2 mile long by 1/4 mile wide, the length possibly to about 100 feet. The highest point is only 10 feet and rising along the ridge where the lake level was, some years ago, one could mount across from the mangrove.

It is now happily an island again from the mangrove. You can see Thomson's Gazelle, D.K. D.K. and a fine herd of Water Buffalo tracks in the sand.

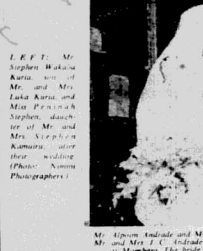

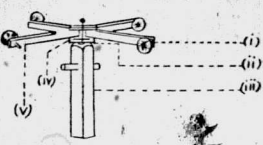
