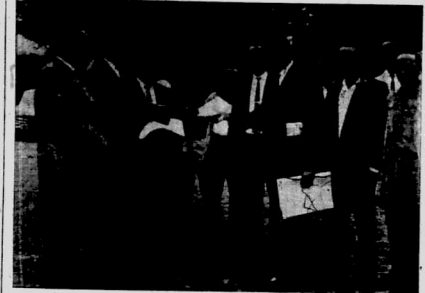

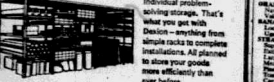



Some prehistoric times, as man began to diversify his activities, the dog has been brought into nearly all forms of human activity, and lauded for the sake of Darius and Menele (charged its shape to suit its purpose).

Gradually, as the dog progressed to be used for all sorts of jobs and good looks. The first dogs to be used for the job and good looks, as King Charles' Spaniel, and the dog which has become prominent in all breeds.

An integral part of the message of the modern dog is the show, an institution which was started in Britain in the early 1800s, and has known no sign of being over.

The East African Kennel Club was organized in 1914 and the first show was held the following year. A glimpse of the breeds exhibited then — Scotchies, Antdies, Fox Terriers, Greyhounds, Dachshunds, Great Danes, Bull Terriers, other breeds, spitzes, pointers, setters and retrievers — shows how little fashions have changed.

Since then, Scotchies and Antdies have been casualties. Fox Terriers are still shown, but the Alaskan has come up from nowhere and today, as in Britain,

it is the most popular breed. Other breeds, which have come overboard, especially since the Second World War, are Poodles, Dalmatians and Pugs.

Primarily responsible for the maintenance of a breed are the breed societies of which there are no less than 21 in East Africa. In countries such as America and Britain, there can be as many as 120. These are for Alabamians, Bull Terriers, Boxers, Chihuahuas, Collies, Dachshunds, Dalmatians, Great Danes, Labradors, Labrador Retrievers, Pitbulls, Poodles, Rottweilers, Scotch Terriers, Spanish Water Dogs, Setters and the new breed, the Yorkshire Terrier.

Some trends are so rare that there are not enough to have separate breed clubs, but their numbers may grow in the future. Examples of this are the Pointer and Whippet.

For shows a year are organized under the Kennel Club at their headquarters at Jamhuri Park. Two are full championship shows (like the one last weekend), the other two are organized by the Ladies' Kennel Association (although men owners can compete) and the other by the breed clubs.

Before a dog can be shown, it must be registered at the Kennel Club office.

In addition, the Alaskan League holds obedience classes, and the Kennel Club organizes training classes for all breeds on Sunday

morning, which members of the public can attend with their dogs. The Kennel Club has between 800 and 500 members with permanent headquarters opposite the Donovan Music Theatre. The President of the Kennel Club, Mr. W. Wilson Smith, stresses that one of the aims of the club is to encourage people in East Africa (there is a branch in Dar es Salaam and one due to open soon in Kampala) to own pedigree dogs, to register and show them.

The judging at shows is done by experienced local and overseas judges, who have to fall strict qualifications. The overseas judges have commented on the high standards of local judges. Some of the East African judges are Mrs. F. R. Spence, second

longest standing member of the club, and former President of the Kenya National Farmers' Union.

Many of the prize-winning dogs in East Africa are imported, promptly to the respective breeding societies. It is a matter of some pride to be bred in East Africa, which is why the best in Show last weekend, bred in East Africa, was by Mrs. F. R. Spence.

New species, of course, are rare, and usually come from what are in the dog world, remote outposts. Occasionally a species which has been around for a long time is recognized by the British Kennel Club and the East Africa Club usually, but not always, follows suit.

At least three outstanding dogs are African in origin — the Saluki, that long-haired Arab dog, the Rhodesian Ridgeback, bred from native Hottentot stock for help in lion-hunting (its English name was "lion-dog"), and the Basenji, a comparatively new to Europe and America, but it has been bred in Africa for centuries past to hunt game. The first one was brought back to Britain by a Congo explorer in 1925, but succumbed to disease.

The Basenji is an unusual dog in many ways. It never barks, but makes a noise, something between a yelp and a howl. It is now well established as a new breed.

Mr. Wilson Smith told me that the "Circus Dog", the little dog seen in villages at the Coast, is probably the nearest indigenous

dog in Africa, and resembles the Basenji. It is possible that this dog could, with careful and selective breeding, be evolved into a new species. Some of the dogs were taken to Britain some years ago but their fate is unknown. The evolution of a truly Kenyan dog would undoubtedly enhance the country's reputation, if only in a limited field, and would presumably present a challenge for local breeders.

Finally, what makes a person choose a particular variety of dog? Mr. Wilson Smith chose Bovers after a lot of experience because "they have no scent glands, make wonderful pets and are marvellous with children."

It is a pity that most dog owners would produce a permutation on these ideas for their own particular preference.

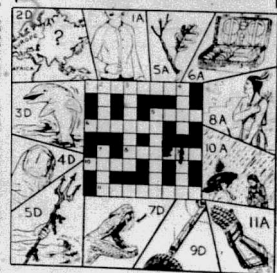

### Scientists of tomorrow

The role of the Kenya Science Teachers' College described by Nathan Odhiambo.

Gone are the days when electricity was taken for granted as a cheap power, and none too are those old days when students marvelled at aeroplanes flying in the sky.

Scientific developments have been so rapid that today advanced nations are producing more than how to get to the moon than how to build an aeroplane.

The most urgent need for rapid of our development has dawned upon our minds in the world. It has been realised that without enough skilled and qualified staff, a country would be left backward in the third world.

In Kenya a start is being made at schools, where that can be described as a technological revolution is being introduced to replace traditional methods of science teaching.

In order to acquire sufficient fully trained teachers for this great task, a new college has been built in Nairobi, offering a three-year course for the training of secondary school teachers in scientific subjects.

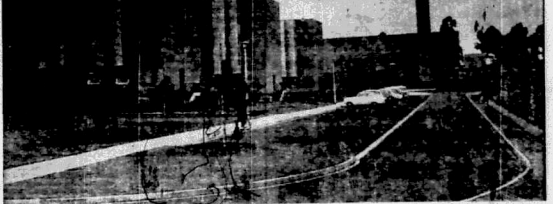
The Kenya Science Teachers' College, four miles from the city centre, Africa, was built as a result of an agreement in 1962 between the Governments of Kenya and Sweden, the latter contributing 90 per cent of the \$1,300,000 capital cost.

The college began its work in 1965. The first students were introduced to the college in 1966. The Ministry for International Development, Austria, through the Swedish International Development Authority, is providing the assistance in the form of grants.

Plans for the Kenya Science Teachers' College were drawn up in collaboration with the Ministry of Education in Kenya, and the understanding that the model was to be fitted into the East African university system.

In 1964, groups of experts were selected at Uppsala University for subjects planned to be taught at the new college in Nairobi. These experts then worked out the syllabus, lists of equipment and proposals for the layout of the building premises.

The university collaborated with the Swedish International Development Authority in the planning work while the National Planning Board took the responsibility for the construction.

work in consultation with the Kenya Government. The link with the university was expected to secure good continuity and quality in the Swedish teaching staff during the period of construction.

In May 1965, an agreement was signed in Nairobi between Sweden and Kenya. As a result, the impressive buildings of the Kenya Science Teachers' College today stand on a 42-acre plot near Jambani Park, an obvious landmark.

Kenya's great interest in the college and its training of its own scientific staff, of modern design, complete with a laboratory, a library, workshop, staffroom, administrative wing, a common room and a dining room, an auditorium and four boarding houses with a total of 288 student beds.

Students entering the college must have a good pass in Kenya School Certificate, particularly in science subjects. A total of 90 men and women can be admitted into the college each year, and when full, the College is capable of accommodating 288 students each.

students are to be trained in reading and writing in English. In addition, a special emphasis is placed on drawing, which will be a compulsory subject for all students.

The initial course of study is for the period of two years, during which the students will be able to reach their own level of proficiency in the use of scientific laboratory technique.

During the second year, the students are allowed to select one of three main courses to study. From the first year onwards, the period three weeks is devoted to the engineering work. The main part of the programme is the study of the sciences, including physics, chemistry and biology.

case. Prospective teachers at Kenya Science Teachers' College are admitted to study for a three-year course. The first two years are devoted to general secondary subjects.

At the college, all the teachers of the students are provided by the Swedish Government. This is in accordance with a bilateral agreement signed between Kenya and Sweden which authorized the latter to support the teachers, apart from contributing 70 per cent of the recurrent costs during the period of the 1967-70 Development Plan.

Heading the Swedish staff of teachers is Dr Eric Bergman, the Principal of the College, a trained scientist of long standing. After graduation as a Bachelor of Science in 1938, he received his doctorate in 1964 and later spent a year in America on nuclear physics research work.

Among his teaching staff, numbering 24, is Miss Brigitta Bernmark, head of the English Department.

The Swedish teachers are in-charge at the College until 1971, when Kenya teachers will be taking over. The Ministry of Education is organising educational visits in such a way as to meet the requirements of the college in the early stages of its operation.

It is in the vital role of providing sufficient numbers of teachers for the new secondary schools that the Kenya Science Teachers' College is expected to play an important part.

Within the next two years, the College will be bringing out an average of 180 secondary school teachers every year. It is specially trained in scientific subjects, and at this rate, Kenya will be able to meet the requirements of the 1989 secondary schools by 1976.

This will help in solving the present acute shortage of trained teachers, and it will also enable the Ministry of Education to organise educational visits in such a way as to meet the requirements of the college in the early stages of its operation.

What's more, it will enable Kenya to keep abreast of the rapid field of technology.

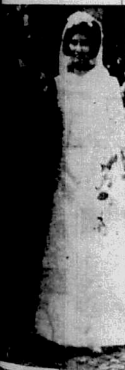

# Target for today's writers

**AN INTRODUCTION TO WEST AFRICAN LITERATURE** by Chinua Achebe  
London, 1964, 10s. 6d.

Contemporary West African literature has been dealt with by several writers and literary critics. Some of these attempts are flawed by the authors' bias, particularly their study on Negritude. Some others the lay man would find rather boring.

Mr. Taiwo's introduction to this subject serves a useful purpose as a sort of a "neutral" ground between the head of the Department of English at the University of Ibadan. His approach is naturally academic. It is more critical.

The book begins with the background of oral traditions and a description of the life and literature of the people. The next section discusses Negritude, the novel, the drama and the poetry - all important literary genres.

The third section selects four major West African writers: Camara Laye's "The African Child", Chinua Achebe's "No Longer at Ease", Cyprian Ekwensi's "People of the City" and Wole Soyinka's "The Lion and the Jewel" and the writer has attempted detailed appraisals of these.

Mr. Taiwo refers to the problem of defining African literature - it is literature written by Africans about Africa or by writers with African background - and prefers to refer to it as African literature. He writes about the background irrespective of the writer's skin. He ends with the hope of African literature becoming an internationally accepted status when it should be favourably compared with the literature of other countries.

On the whole, Mr. Taiwo's introduction to West African literature will be found useful by the senior school students.

# Why dahlia is a favourite

It is fairly simple to grow dahlias in East Africa. We have no frost to contend with and are not called upon to lift the plants to prevent the tubers being damaged.

Most gardeners have their tubers in the soil for one year in the autumn, and plant them the following year. It is better to lift the tubers in the autumn and replant after a short rest. This gives the new growth a better chance of coming into fruit, as the tubers are now normally associated with the following year.

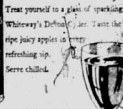

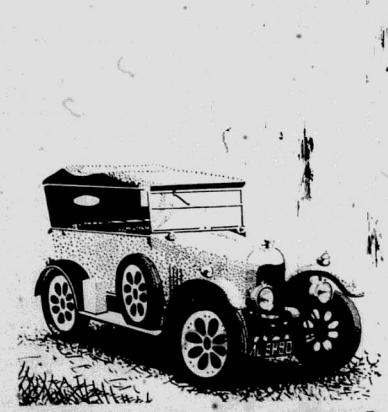
