NOT SUFFICIENT EVIDENCE TO JUSTIFY A TRIAL.

great deal of public interest was created in commercial circles in Nairobi yesterday by the 'East African Standard's' report of a case heard in the Magistrate's Court in which a European was discharged on the grounds of insufficient evidence in connection with an allegation of obtaining goods from an Indian store-keeper by false pretences.

It will be remembered that in the case in question the accused gave a post-dated cheque which was returned by the Bank marked 'No account' and the Magistrate held that there did not appear to have been any misrepresentation implying that account actually had an account at the Bank at the time.

In view of the importance which is attached by commercial and banking circles and by the general public to the ruling, the Magistrate's brief judgment is given in full.

Endorsed "No Account."

On Monday a European appeared before the Resident Magistrate, Nairobi, on a charge of obtaining goods under false pretences from an Indian merchant. David Robertson of Chakaya Street, Nairobi, said that he had been induced to part with the value of Shs. 150.00 on credit being advanced by a post-dated cheque which was accepted without question. A few days later the cheque was returned to him marked "no account."

In reply to the Magistrate's plaintiff said that nothing had been mentioned by the accused being post-dated. Witness made no objection about receiving a post-dated cheque from "his customer."

No Account Since 1920. An official of the Standard Bank of South Africa said the accused had had no account with the bank since the date of the cheque.

The petition stated that the Native Land Trust (ordinance of 1908), that if land in a Native Reserve was required for developing the mineral wealth of the Colony not only would those concerned with the land be compensated with money but also with an equal area of land. The petition was 'unsuccessfully' annulled by the Amending Ordinance of December, 1931.

On July 11 on the debate on the Colonial Office vote, the Secretary of State for the Colonies made with this petition. He reported it and said 'none of the natives who presented this petition are in the Kavirondo Goldfields area.' (Hawarden). In conclusion I would say that the car with Airwheels saved many hours of severe labour which I could hardly have undertaken with the personnel at my command.

Thus, having confidence in their efficiency, I reduced the native personnel for 3 cars to 2 only only.

The replacement of the Airwheels aided largely in the reduction of vibration and bumps to the car, thus saving wear and tear to Chassis, Body and Engine.

In my opinion these wheels have resulted a revolution in the problems of desert travel. The longevity of soft sand, which has led to the modification of all desert trips, has now disappeared.

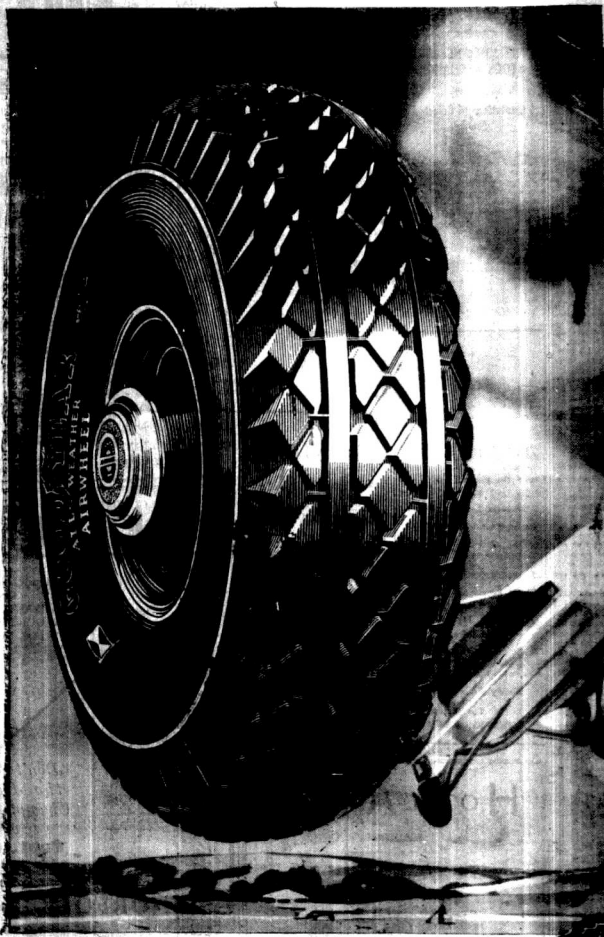

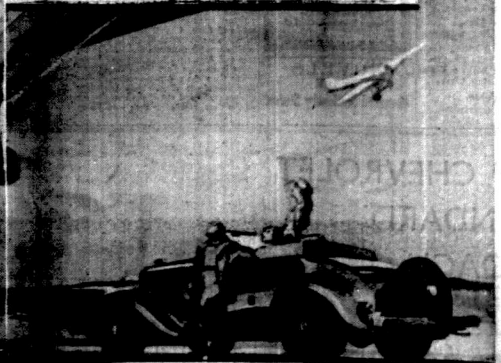

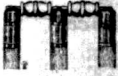

For commodities (in the nature of) history) which cannot be imported, and through many people gen- erally that it contains the seeds of the native world cease to grow, the oppo- site has been the case. 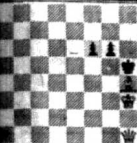

Dr. Emanuel Lasker, ex-emption of the world, quotes this problem in his recent book and gives the solution as follows:—

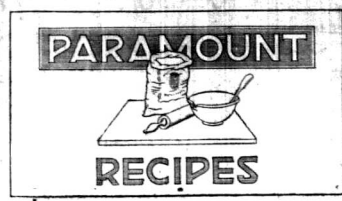

J. Babson, Missouri: When a Pawn is promoted, the new piece is in play immediately; you have not to wait until the next move. 1. Should a Queen, for example, be chosen, you say "Check!" immediately the Pawn reaches the back line if the enemy King is Menaced by the new Queen. You may Castle on either side, i.e., with either the KK or QR. The rules being:—

PARAMOUNT RECIPES

SPONGE CAKE
 (Egg Sponge).

Ingredients:—
 4-lb. "Kenya's Paramount" Flour.
 1-lb. loaf sugar.
 7-eggs.
 1-teaspoonful of water. A pinch of salt.

Method:—
 Put sugar and water into a saucepan to melt, and bring to boil. Break eggs into a basin and beat for at least half an hour, then pour gradually the sugar from a height on to the eggs, whisking all the time, and continue to whisk for another 20 minutes.
 Dry the flour and rub through a sieve with salt, and when egg mixture is thick and frothy stir in flour very gently and lightly.
 Place this mixture in a well greased and floured tin, and bake in moderate oven for 1 or 1 1/2 hours, taking care not to open oven door for at least 1 hour after cake has been put in.
 Close and open oven door gently, as excessive vibration or a sudden draught of air will cause the cake to sink.
