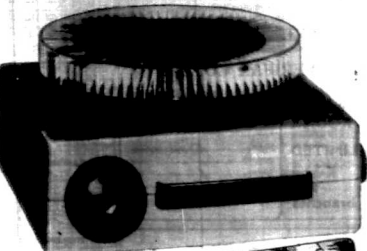

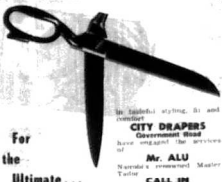

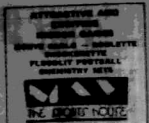

NAM: BIG DRIVE STARTED

Attempt to reconnect vital supply route

SOUTH Vietnamese Government forces have launched one of their biggest sweeps in an attempt to clear a vital highway for a convoy carrying food and ammunition to the Central Highlands base of Pleiku. A U.S. military spokesman said the convoy left the coastal city of Qui Nhon, about 275 miles north-east of Saigon, early yesterday along Route 19, the most fiercely contested stretch of road in the country.

The convoy was expected to reach Pleiku, about 240 miles north-north-east of Saigon, and 180 miles from Qui Nhon, sometime today. The spokesman declined to disclose the number of Government units involved in the road-clearing operation.

OUTPOST AWAITS ITS FATE

The fate of a small outpost in the Central Highlands of South Vietnam is being decided by a battle between Communist forces and Government troops. The outpost, located in the mountainous region of Dak Tin, is being held by a small force of Government troops. BIGGEST EARTH SATELLITE NOW IN ORBIT

Vietcong cut the road link between Pleiku and Qui Nhon early in June, blowing up three bridges, apparently as part of a plan to throw a gradually tightening noose around Pleiku. Qui Nhon, Cho Lo and other Central Highlands provincial capitals.

The Government operations began on Friday morning when troops moved into position to clear and hold the road while engineers repaired the bridges.

Mr. Toure said the sub-committee was working very hard in its attempt to reach a settlement. The talks resumed at 9 pm last night; delegates had met throughout the day.
