

ABERDARES OPENED UP TO FAMILY MOTORIST

LISBIE LADY enjoyed a drive along the Aberdare National Park road from Nairobi to the Queen Mother's residence in the Aberdare National Park.

ALTHOUGH as I write the road through the Aberdare National Park is closed due to the onset of the long rains, I thought it would be of interest to the average motorist to have a little more about the journey by and his wife and family will find what they go sightseeing and picnicking later on in the dark addition to the National Parks family.

I was told by Mr. G. C. Alexander, Warden of the Aberdare National Park, that the park, which encompasses 1,000 square miles of land, has not already been visited by many people with enough experience to make the trip difficult.

STOP FOR TOLL

As I drove up over Mbera hill and not the hillsides, I did not pay the toll except at the entrance to the park, where there is a toll booth. The toll is 10 cents per vehicle, and the money goes to the park, which is run by the Forestry Commission.

The toll is collected by a man who carries a rifle and a shotgun, and driving had remained a pleasure.

The drive up over Mbera hill is a delight, with a winding road, which is paved, and the view of the forested hillsides on either side of the road.

Nasser reveals Reds' plan for power

PRESIDENT Nasser claimed in an interview published in New York's *Today* magazine that intelligence agencies developed a "Communist master-plan".

The plot, he said, was to "overthrow and replace" a "Red Arab" government.

The present would be a "momentous year" in which Lebanon and Kuwait would be overthrown and the Persian Gulf would be taken over by the Reds.

Mr. Nasser said that the United States would be held responsible if the Reds were to succeed in their plan.

The interview was given to a reporter from the *Washington Post* after the Foreign Minister had been interviewed by a Paris newspaper.

The president told Mr. R. K. Aspinwall, editor of the *Post*, that he planned to be named soon to succeed Mr. Macmillan as Secretary of State.
