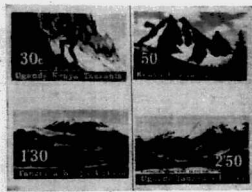
Four new stamps

The Director-General of the East African Posts and Telecommunications Corporation has announced the issue of four postage stamps, which are of the following denominations: 30 and 40 cents, 1.30 and 2.50. It will be used for all postal matters in Kenya, Uganda and Tanzania.

The stamps were designed by the artist, Mr. J. M. Kariuki, Nairobi, Kenya, and printed by the photographic process on non-perforated paper. The size is 1.1" x 1.175" perforated in perforation, in horizontal format.

Details of the design and colours (seen below) are as follows: Value of 30 cents, design: sunbursting in East Africa, 4 colours, brown, blue, yellow and black; 40 cents, design: giraffe, blue and brown; 1.30, design: Mt. Kenia, blue, violet and green; 2.50, design: Mt. Kenia, blue, violet and green.

Official Postage Centres for use with the new stamps will be set up at all towns, each at all selling offices. Special order forms can be obtained from any post office and a reproduction of it will appear in the local Press on dates to be given nearer the date of issue.

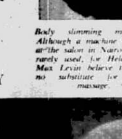

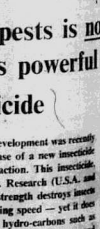

U.S. Vietnamese smash through U.S. defences

U.S. Vietnamese troops charging in behind tanks and flame-trumpets yesterday breached the perimeter of an American Special Forces camp at Lang Vei, forcing the approach to the Khe Sanh Marine base. Late last night the North Vietnamese News Agency claimed that Communist forces had captured the Lang Vei airport.

The Americans, locked by Montagnard (hillman) auxiliaries, fought for their lives from concrete bunkers dotted along a narrow ridge, swept by bullets and shells.

The Communists, using tanks for the first time in the Vietnam war, attacked the Lang Vei outpost behind a screen of flame-trumpets. Four of the tanks blew up under fire, but one knocked out a 400 T-34. A quarter-past midnight the air strikes stopped that two other tanks, although disabled, were still firing at the American position.

Artillery barrage

The North Vietnamese greeted their assault by an intense artillery barrage, and the Khe Sanh base from the east was subjected to a hail of shells and rockets throughout the night.

The North Vietnamese were still holding out in Hue, where they have set up a bridge over the Perfume River linking the two parts of the city in an attempt to prevent the American landing reinforcements into the city.

Hue, which has been in Communist hands for more than a week, is only two days away from the city.

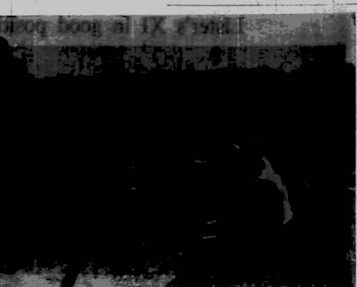

American forces have scored one success in the city of Hue, where Marines have dugged for fuel and ammunition on the edge of the city. Also in Hue, an unknown number of North Vietnamese prisoners have been burned to death.

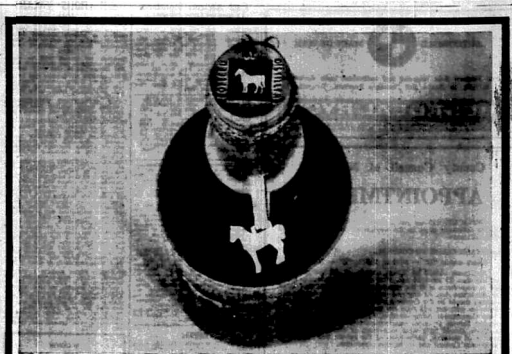

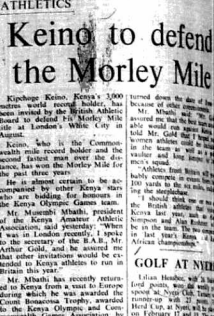
