WEST SEEKS ANSWER TO BERLIN CHALLENGE

New Russian Move on eve of talks

PARIS MEETINGS

WESTERN leaders were gathering in Paris yesterday for a series of vital conferences to decide on a concerted answer to the Soviet challenge over Berlin, and to review the state of the Atlantic Alliance.

The first of these was held last night between the Foreign Ministers of the United States, Britain, France and Western Germany, with discussion of Western counter-measures to the Russian proposal for the ending of Berlin's Four-Power status and the creation of a demilitarized free city at the Western Zone.

Today there is to be a meeting of the Ministerial Council of the Council of Europe and tomorrow the North Atlantic Treaty Organization's Ministerial Council will begin its annual three-day conference. There are also to be meetings during the week of the Councils of Western European Deputies and the Organisation for European Economic Co-operation.

Aim to relax tension

On the eve of these Western deliberations, the Soviet Union has made public a new Note—supposed to be sent to the Nato Powers in which the demand for a permanent conference with the aim of relaxing international tensions is renewed. Copies of it were delivered to the Moscow embassies of the countries concerned on Saturday.

The Note, after restating the Russian proposals for Berlin, repeats suggestions of a non-aggression pact between Nato countries and the members of the Communist Warsaw Pact. It also proposes free reductions by both East and West and the introduction of some form of the Paris Plan.

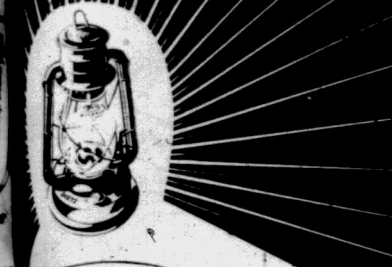

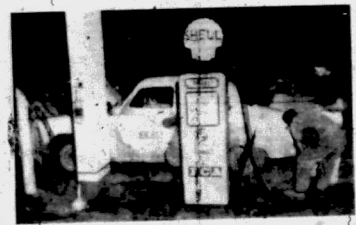

THE SNAIL'S ANCESTOR COMES UP FROM THE DEPTHS

LIVING specimens of Paleocene Snailings - a snail-like creature believed extinct for about 200,000,000 years - have been recovered from the floor of the Pacific Ocean. Columbia University reported yesterday.

Dr. John Imbrie, Associate Professor of Geology, described the snailings as "The ancestor of snails and slugs, most of small snails that cling to rocks on the seafloor and are quite common today". He said the recently discovered specimens were virtually unchanged from their predecessors of 200,000,000 years ago, when the snailings first appeared on Earth.

The two oldest living links with the past originally inhabited the shallow water along the shore, but apparently had to go to deeper depths to look for food, Dr. Imbrie said.

SOVIET WARNING ON BERLIN: DANGER OF ATOM-WAR

West urged to be 'realistic'
NATO DISCUSSIONS

US has told the Western Powers that a war over Berlin would involve the use of atomic and nuclear weapons. The warning, made in a 1,000-word statement reiterating the Russian attitude in Berlin, came just as the Foreign Ministers of Britain, France, U.S. and West Germany were preparing to meet in Paris to discuss the Berlin situation.

The U.S. Secretary of State, Mr. Dulles, conferred with President Eisenhower at the White House yesterday before flying to Paris, where he will meet Western colleagues who will hold private talks tomorrow before the formal opening on Tuesday of the Nato Council.

The Dulles statement claimed that Russia was ready to talk on talks on concluding a German peace treaty signed by the Western Powers to adopt a 'realistic' attitude to the Soviet proposals to end the four-Power status of the city and around the United States of creating a 'sphere' to be ruled through the city.

U.S. unflinched by threats
The threatening tone of the Russian Note was reinforced by remarks by Mr. Krushchev in an interview with the Soviet press. The Soviet Prime Minister also said the high-ranking Western military men talked about backing a way to Berlin with troops and tanks. In the face of such suggestions the Soviet Union would fulfil its Warsaw Pact obligations and defend the East German GDR.

It was pointed out the U.S. State Department communique on the Russian statement, said the United States 'will not desert' by threats from defending its rights and maintaining its responsibilities to 2,225,000 free people in West Berlin. America would not accept Russia's unilateral decision to withdraw from East Berlin after six months.

Fishermen who ignore 'dangerous' dose of radiation

SCIENTISTS are investigating the ripple of nearly 100,000 fishermen who have been exposed to a high dose of radiation in a biological genetic drama. The fishermen live along 400 miles of the palm-fringed coast of Kerala state in South India. They have been eating fish from the deposits of uranium-bearing sand and sludge there; and for centuries the fishermen have been exposed to radiation from them. According to Indian scientists, some of the fish caught there is as much as 50 times the normal strontium-90 content.

Among the worst affected is the town of Kadalpanadu, where 6,000 fishermen live. Many of the fishermen have been found to be high strontium-90. The Government's Atomic Energy Department has estimated that the people of this coastal belt are getting an average of 1.5 rads annually. This is a dose of 500 times the average of 0.3 rads/year. This means that the fishermen are getting an average of 300 rads annually. This is a dose of 1,000 times the normal dose. The Government is now studying the health effects of this radiation.

This dose of 30 to 40 rads annually is a dose which is now being accepted by scientists as dangerous although they have yet to establish what is a safe level of radiation which can be absorbed by the human body without damage. But this is found only in the fall-out from nuclear explosions and is not a threat to health from natural sources. 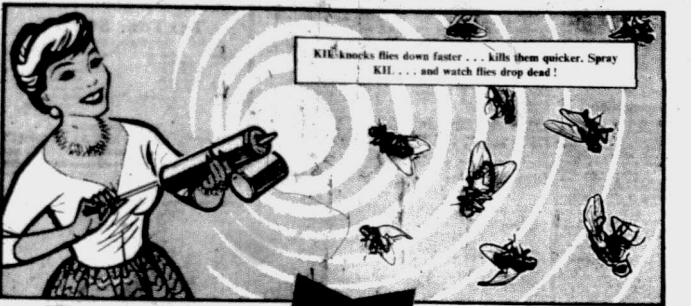

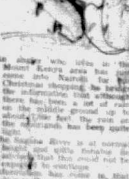

SAVING WILD LIFE

Among matters on which the Conservancy Office sought the advice of the British Nature Conservancy Commission was the proposed extension of the park, which was announced September 28, 1956, was the Serengeti Park.

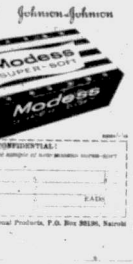

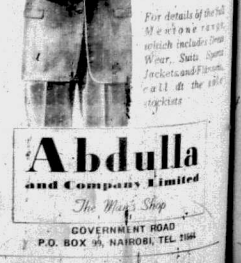

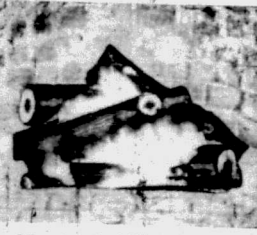

Ceiling on assessment of employees' housing proposed
