REPORTED SOVIET-ARAB AGREEMENT

RUSSIAN CONDEMNED ON CHINESE TREATY ISSUE

Britain among 25 abstentions

THE United Nations Political Committee has condemned the Soviet-Union for its abstention for failing to carry out its treaty of friendship and alliance with China.

The resolution also found that the Soviet-Union had prevented the Government of the Republic of China from re-establishing its National authority in the National Government.

The resolution moved by the United States and supported by 25 other members of the committee, was adopted by a vote of 25 to 1, with 25 abstentions.

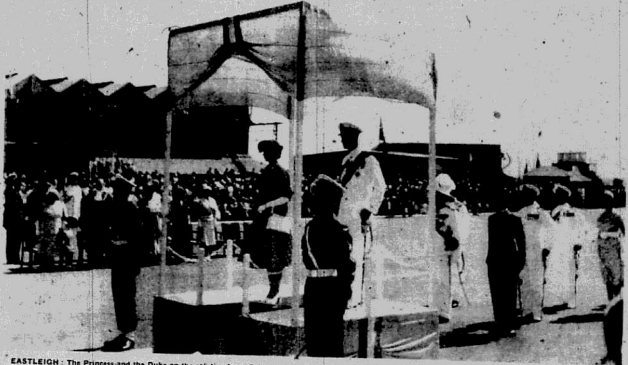

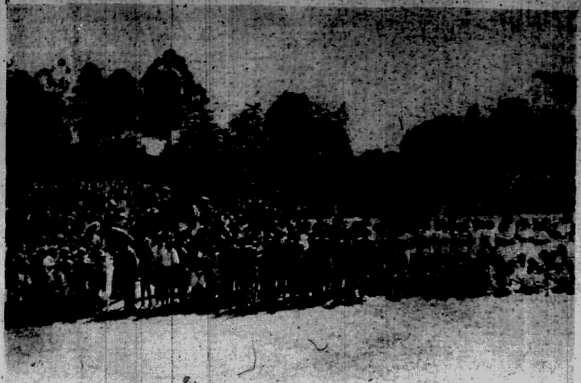

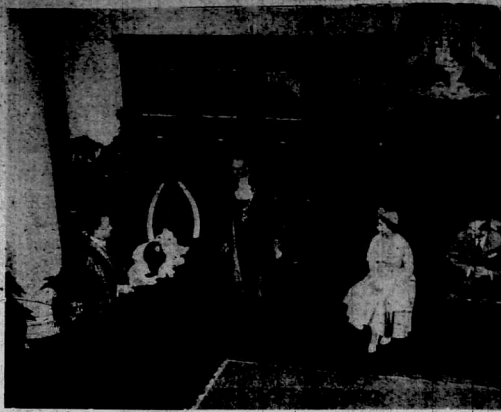

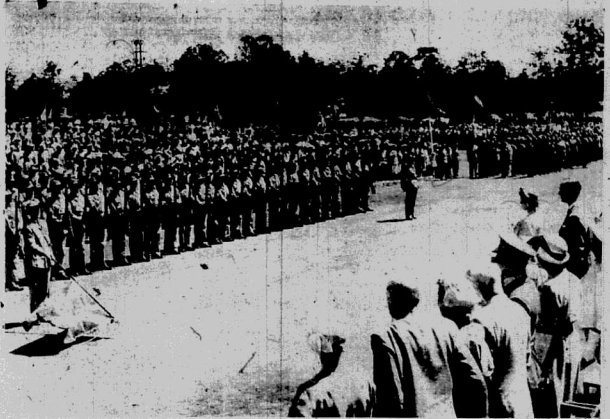
