Mr. Eden discusses foreign affairs

MR. ANTHONY EDEN, Foreign Secretary, opening a Commons debate on foreign affairs, was not too far from being undecisive. Many factors have helped to bring this about, he said. Firstly, there is the growth of strength of the Western nations, which though still relatively modest in comparison with the former imperial armies, becomes more and more evident every month. Secondly, the recent Assembly of the League of Nations, on the whole less violent in controversy, though marred by the recent Greek episode. 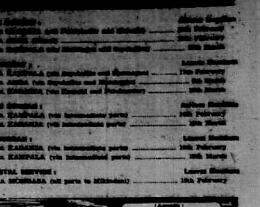
