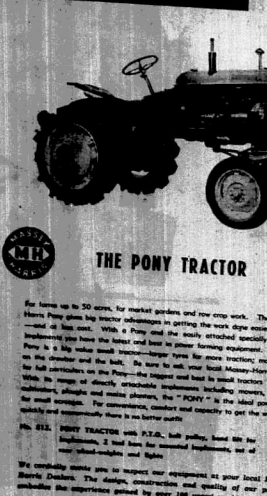

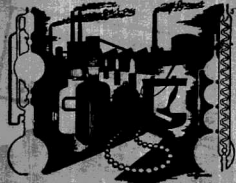

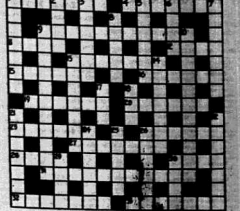

OFFICERS' SAME STORY ABOUT SINKING Inquiry evidence into loss of Dutch liner

QUESTIONS were asked at an official inquiry in Amsterdam into the sinking of the 18,000-ton Dutch liner *Kliphoven* about an alleged agreement among the ship's officers to tell the same story about the sinking. The *Kliphoven* sank after striking an underwater shoal off the coast of Portuguese East Africa on January 9, 1953. All her 116 passengers and 114 crew took to the boats and were picked up by the British liner *Stormenton* of Cardiff, Wales.

The British liner, the *Kliphoven's* officers drew up a written statement. This first mate P. Akerman told the inquiry that the statement was dictated by the captain, Johan H. Oostenhuis, at the grave. President of the inquiry, W. van Marrewijk agreed that when the *Kliphoven* struck the shoal, the captain could have been misled by the statements of the officers. He said that this was not unusual during the drafting of the statement.

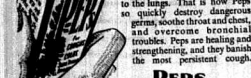

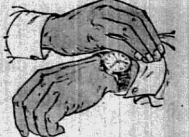

New rates for Territorial Forces

Experts' Report Tabled

New rates of pay for the Territorial Force, and also, in addition, for the Territorial Force Reserve, were announced in the Federal Parliament by the Minister of Defence.

The Minister recalled that, with the introduction of the new system of continuous training—National Service—under the Defence (Interns) Act passed last year, it was intended that men for four and a half months would be available for the Territorial Force on an October 1, and the second intake February every year, with about half of the latter men in each.

"It has now been decided," the Minister said, "that there will be eight intake a year. Each intake will consist of considerable numbers of men eligible for service.

"Some of the advantages of this system are that industry will not be disrupted; there are no losses within the ranks; the rank period is easier; training costs will be considerably less; and the continuity of service will be effected."

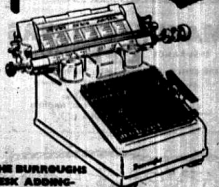

Strikers condemned by court of inquiry

20,000 NEWSPAPER MEN MAY LOSE JOBS TODAY

THE British Government was making a lighthour attempt yesterday to secure a settlement of the 21-day-old newspaper strike before 20,000 workers outside the dispute lose their jobs.

Sir Walter Monckton, the Minister of Labour, called representatives of the Newspaper Proprietors Association and the two unions concerned to urgent talks with conciliation officers. At this meeting the Ministry's offers were prevailing but parties to the dispute are to settle their dispute on the basis of a report published by a Government court of inquiry.

The report criticized the strike leaders for "unjustified and unbusinesslike" demands and "unjustified" and "unbusinesslike" wage claims.

Power failure caused by lightning

THE UNUSUAL AND THE RARE ON A RANCH AT ELEMENTEITA

In seeking the unusual and the rare, I found it after a long and dusty drive, at the house of Lord and Lady Claud Hamilton at Elementeita. The land on which the house now stands was bought by Lady Claud's father in 1927 and she herself, with the aid of local labour, planned and built it in 1930. Through a forest of acacia thorn trees I looked towards Lake Nakuru and the Masai Mountains and understood why the owners had chosen this particular site for their lovely home.

Inside, it is replete with the history of their ancestors and imbued with the atmosphere of the many unusual things collected on numerous journeys round the world.

Coastal hair rugs from Kurdistan are scattered in many of the rooms, the door posts leading from the small entrance hall into the sitting-room are of black oak been from timber of old ships to the order of Lady Claud's great-uncle, Admiral Lord Gambier of Vere, Bucks. In the sitting-room no one can pass without a second glance the striking picture of the work of disabled soldiers after World War I is that of Nelson's ship, the Victory, from a painting by the artist, W. H. Payne. A French serpentine-fronted chest of drawers, a Koran chest standing on a tiny Chinese dining table, a chest inlaid with mother-of-pearl, three magnificent Spanish chairs... all speak to me of travels in many distant lands. The set of prints round the walls was of horses, and refers in costume through the ages.

An English harriet organ, no longer now, alas, capable of being played, is still treasured by Lady Claud from her childhood days, although her preference, in that particular room, is obviously for a picture of a Knight, the work of Howard Wylie, son of the artist of the Victory picture.

On one side of the long enclosed verandah, with its huge double doors opening on to the terrace and looking beyond to the ornamental pool. Scattered with geraniums, is a cabinet displaying Dresden and Sevres china; on it stands a Blenheim horn which belonged to the Abyssinian Emperor, Theodore. Lady Claud's grandfather, Admiral Sir Leopold Heath, led the naval contingent of the Abyssinian campaign.

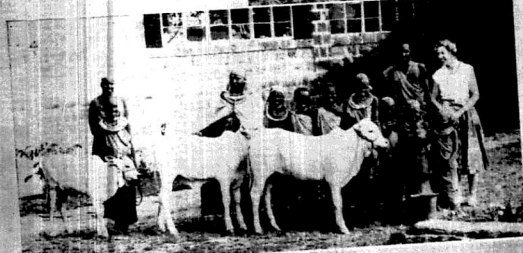
Passing the farm office on the left, in which Lord Claud was at work, I looked into Lady Claud's small sitting-room with its Louis Seize sofa and armchairs. Here was a walnut tallboy with sundials at foot; pictures of their Surrey property, the house of the late Lord Claud, and the main bedroom, with its corner fireplace, more Louis Seize chairs, a canopy bed, a chaise longue. Beyond was a small sleeping porch with its own modern pink-decorated bathroom.

From Bali had come the piece of Batik bag on one wall; on another was the Maharaja's coat from Manchuria. Saved from the time of the great fire at the Paris Exhibition of 1889, is a mirror-backed walnut table still bearing scorch marks.

Two Louis XIII slope-back chairs, straight-back chairs made in France, and a glass wood table are part of the furnishings of the small dining saloon, in which is a varied assortment of portraits and pictures as I have ever seen—family likenesses and paintings from both sides of the family, a score of miniatures—almost a museum of family life hangs on those walls. A handsome 18th-century Spanish leather screen, with pictures of cavaliers and ladies, and a William and Mary sideboard lend further character.

Quite recently there was in the house a harp which had belonged to Emma, Lady Hamilton—who, by the way, is no connection of Lord Claud Hamilton. When it began to fall into disrepair, Lady Claud—who had acquired it from Mrs. Nelson Ward and her sister—sent it as a gift to the Nelson collection in Monmouthshire so that it could be preserved for the nation.

But Lord Claud and his wife do not live in the past in spite of their many historical and beautiful possessions; they have much to do on their large cattle ranch. The authorities of the War of 48 Game is at work, on his second book, and just before I left she called up over small Masai children, headless, neckless and eager to show their teeth were pressing under the tutelage of Isabel Potts, who is interpreting words in the showing of Boran cattle at future agricultural shows.
