

THE U.S. Senate has passed President Eisenhower's tariff-cutting bill, giving him a first big victory over protectionists trying to block his new liberalized foreign trade programme.

Cooperation of the Democrats' majority gave the President the tariff-cutting powers denied him when his own Republican Party controlled Congress.

The bill was approved after the Senate had rejected a series of protectionist amendments in a new tariff or quota bill.

The Eisenhower bill gives the President authority to cut tariffs on 1,300 products and to set a 15 per cent import duty on the remainder.







RUSSIA CALLS FOR AN END TO COLD WAR

Disarmament plan could halt tension, STATEMENT WELCOMED BY WESTERN POWERS

THE Russian Prime Minister, Marshal Bulganin, has called for an end to the "cold war" and invitation for a meeting of Big Four leaders.

He told a conference of Communist nations in Warsaw for a disarmament, announced which Western proposals for disarmament could be ended by the Big Four. The proposals include a halt to the occupying forces of Germany and the elimination of troops of Germany and the establishment of a German on an equal footing with the other three.

The disarmament plan, which was signed by Britain, France and the United States as well as by the Soviet Union, was welcomed by Western powers. It is a major step towards the end of the cold war.

Secondly, the Soviet Union has agreed to the elimination of nuclear weapons and the complete prohibition of the production of nuclear weapons.
