### Inter-union conflict a stumbling block

#### 1,000,000 UNEMPLOYED NEXT WEEK FORECAST

LEADERS of Britain's Trades' Union Congress began a great effort yesterday to settle differences behind the five-day rail strike. The biggest obstacle is the divergent views on pay between the locomotive men's union and that representing the remainder of the rail workers.

The aim of the T.U.C. is to see the two unions, the Associated Society of Locomotive Engineers and Firemen, whose 70,000 members are on strike, and the National Union of Railwaymen thrust on a common policy on wages matters before resuming negotiations with the Transport Commission.

T.U.C. little progress has been made. The secretary of the N.U.R. Mr. Jim Campbell, who leads 400,000 workers, met T.U.C. leaders for 75 minutes. He said later that there was "no immediate hope of any solution."

Paralleling the labour leaders' attempt to bring about a settlement, the Cabinet met to discuss a strengthening of the Government's emergency programme which, however, seems to be working better than expected. Train services, though still slow, are more regular and workers in London and other major centres had no difficulty in getting to their jobs. Road traffic was much easier.

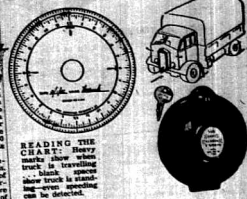

Salary revision raises Labour Department costs

EXPENDITURE on Kenya's Labour Department will increase by £25,000 to £225,000 in the coming financial year. Mr. C. H. Hartwell, Minister of Labour, told Kenya's Legislative Council on Wednesday. The increased expenditure was due to the salaries revision and to the creation of a small number of posts.

ASCENDING MT. KANGCHENJUNGA

Mountaineers trek through the long valley of tumbled iceblocks

This latest dispatch from CHARLES EVANS, leader of the British expedition which has conquered Kangchenjunga in the Himalayas, after the highest mountain peak in the world, was sent from Camp 3 before the successful ascent.

OUR first task, once at the foot of Kangchenjunga, has been to retrace the route suggested and illustrated in the first article of this series, that is, to ascend the valley of the Lower Lefal to the possible continuation through the Lower Lefal to the base of the foot of the Upper Lefal, where we hoped to place Camp 2.

During the past two weeks we have carried out this reconnaissance and have been forced to discontinue the Rock Buttress and the Lower Lefal as a way to the Upper Lefal, as however, it has been found that we have a better route to the top of the mountain by the Lower Lefal and farther, taking it to be the most direct route between the two ledges.

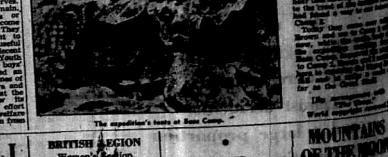

## SCIENTISTS IN CEYLON FOR SOLAR ECLIPSE

MORE than a hundred scientists and astronomers from East and West will be in Ceylon to watch the eclipse of the sun which is due to take place on June 20, at about 3 P.M.

Teams of astro-physicists from Britain, Australia, India, U.S.A., Switzerland, Holland, and other countries are setting up camps at Hinigrukoddi and Palakumbura in the wilderness of some jungles to make the most of the precious seven minutes which the eclipse is expected to last. In that short time, they hope to test and collect further data on Einstein's theory of relativity.

The scientists are staying in modern government bungalows and the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization building in the area.

Professor Mervinragan says that a solar eclipse will not be seen in Ceylon for at least another 150 years.
