VIEWING THE 'OLD COUNTRY' WITH A CRITICAL EYE . . .

Having not visited my home country — England — for quite a few years, I felt that this time I was possibly viewing observations were made through the windows of a variety of hotels and not in the more kindly light of one's own — always a jaundiced outlook in whatever country one finds oneself — and have tried to take this into account for my own interest. I have set out these observations on a number of aspects of English life today as I found it. Some, I realize, are general but others, I am sure, are single-statements of truth which have ceased to strike the English as in any way unusual by reason of daily observation putting me right where my observations are wrong. As I am sure they



now in Kenya, could reply to this article with his or her must be in many instances as my impressions were gathered in a very short stay indeed.

KENYA during the past three years, since my previous visit, the man in the street undoubtedly has revised his mental picture of the position in which the White settler in Kenya has been placed by the policy of the British Government and there has been a change in his own attitude.

This however, is as far as I am concerned, and little real interest in the Empire take over. The news of the overseas and news of Africa is a bore and to be skipped if possible. "The all right Jack" is the real creed of the average Englishman today — and who can really blame him for that.

SOCIAL PROBLEM

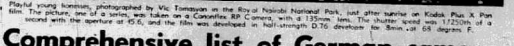
