**MICHIGAN**—High state of technical expertise, and detailed knowledge of chess theory has been gained by the chess players who have come to the country to compete in tournaments. In order that his best efforts may be given full scope...

This is particularly the case among chess experts, where the game is a serious study, and requires a great deal of thought to do more than obtain a draw. The scope of the game has been reduced in order to break away from the routine of masters chess, many of the younger players are now turning to the game of making moves which are not always obviously good, but which are more calculated to confuse the opponent. The game is thus altered to accommodate the natural ability of the beginner player, even so...

In the following game, Parkinson, 18, is up to the task, and shows how he can beat even the best players with his own brand of chess. He has been beaten by both Keres and Keres' son, and is now ready to go to the wood on the board. At the time the 25th move had been made, he was still in a strongly winning position. In the mean time, however, White made a series of errors, and Keres achieves his object, and wins the game, and gives a lesson in chess to all who are interested in a new and interesting development...

## SELF-HELP

**MONDAY, OCTOBER 6, 1947.** As was to be expected, the new referendum, Mr. Bevin, to Britain's union for the British Commonwealth, has been received with the support of the majority of the people throughout the country. It is clear that the majority of the people in Kenya would have voted for the same result had there been a third option available. We must realize that the position of self-government in this period of unprecedented financial strain is such that it would be to everyone's advantage if Britain, the Commonwealth, and the British Empire were to remain as sympathetically associated as a unit for a considerable time to come. In this period of inter-state conferences, Britain's position cannot be solved by a vote of the people alone. For Britain's union with a European Union, or with America's overseas trade, may be desirable, but certainly not now. The Commonwealth, to work with Europe, supplied 85 per cent of exports and import almost 80 per cent of imports.
