

SIR ROY ASH OF 'SELECTION' Britain accused of not caring what happens Southern Rhodesians who believed in culture and civilization would get an assist from Mr. Macmillan's Government in London. Sir Roy Welenski's Federal Prime Minister, said yesterday on his return from London talks on the break-up of the Rhodesian Federation.

"They have told us out and do not care what happens now," he said in a reference to Britain's decision to allow Northern Rhodesia to secede from the Federation.

Southern Rhodesians could not afford not to get independence now, "It is the duty of everyone, white and black, to see this is obtained. There has got to be a change of ranks."

'Summoned a la Hitler'

Asked about the chances of Southern Rhodesia's independence if a Labour Government came to power in Britain, Sir Roy said he "cannot deal with anything worse than we have had in the last five years. At least they might stay in or the break and not put their arms round us and find a soft spot to dig in the back."

The Prime Minister said he and Mr. Butler had been discussing specific people such as the Federation's next Governor-General only two days before it was announced, a la Hitler and told what our future was going to be.

Sir Roy said, "The working of the Federal Government and maintenance of the Charter of the Federation must go on and as long as I am here, the will as it does go on will do nothing to help break of the Federation."

When Sir Roy passed through Harare earlier yesterday he said that had the British Government "the slightest bit of sympathy" it could have saved not only the greatest economic but the political life as well.

"If the Federation does break up it will break up because of the set of the British Government," Sir Roy said.

He was not castigating anyone but he was certain there would be a certain amount of bitterness if it happened from outside the Federation.

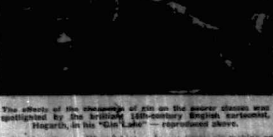

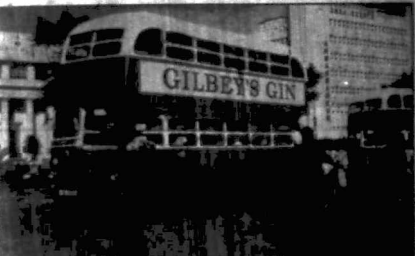

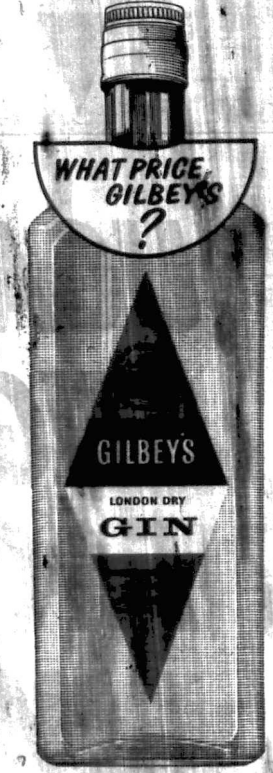

WHAT'S IN A NAME?

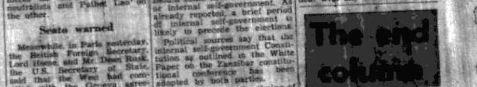

Met. experts to train at Royal College

A SCHEME to train meteorologists in developing African countries has been presented to the Council of the World Meteorological Organisation (W.M.O.) in Geneva.

The plan provides for the establishment of meteorological departments in the Royal College in Nairobi and Dar es Salaam (Tanzania) University.

The meteorology course will begin in Nairobi in July while negotiations are in progress with the Tanzanian Government with regard to Dar es Salaam. In the interim, assistants will be provided from the funds of the expanded programme of Technical Assistance.

Four regional training centres have been proposed in Nairobi, Kampala, Addis Ababa and Lagos. A regional training centre will also be proposed for the training of meteorological assistants in Dar es Salaam.

DAMAGES AWARD CUT BY PRIVY COUNCIL

AN appeal by the United Marketing Co. Ltd., Nairobi, insurance agents, which was ordered by the Kenya Supreme Court to pay damages for breach of contract after insurance stock had been destroyed in a shop fire, was dismissed with costs by the Privy Council in London.

The London court, headed by Lord Hailsham, reduced the amount of the damages award from £25,000 to £10,000, saying that by an over-estimate the damages had been wrongly assessed.

The appeal was in favour of Mr. William Katz, boss of a Nairobi firm, who had a shop in Market Street, Nairobi, which was destroyed by fire on a night in April, 1958. He sued the insurance agents, alleging that he had been misled by their policy of payment in the shop year by year.

Lord Hailsham said that there were numerous findings of fact against the insurance agents. When the government servant was employed on a casual basis from a commercial point of view, the agents were not necessarily responsible with the exception of Mr. Katz, who had been involved.

A new contention that damages should be assessed on an assumption that Mr. Katz was an insurance agent, which was a bare question of law that Lord Hailsham would not entertain, the proposition without the benefit of judgment in the Court of Appeal on the point.

The appeal award would be with interest at the rate fixed by the trial judge.
