**Report rejects idea of currency split**

Bank system in East Africa, with four State banks for Kenya, Uganda and Zanzibar assuming territorial autonomy, is recommended in a report to the Government by a German financial expert. Herr Weisner strongly advises the Government against buying to establish a Trans-Africa currency and central bank of its own, which would lead to the nominal borders of East Africa being turned into real frontiers.

It would also probably cause a steadily widening rift in the economic co-operation among the East African countries and joint planning for development of industrial areas would be impossible because of competition among the territories.

Herr Weisner also rejects the belief that the creation of a central bank for East Africa is impracticable, or at least not yet practicable because of the absence of a federation and of a federal political executive. He proposes the setting up of a two-level central bank system to get over this difficulty.

**Right to issue currency**

At the top would be the central bank, established on a regional basis in agreement of the East African Governments, which would take over the assets and liabilities of the present East African Currency Board, and which would have the sole right to issue legal tender.

Incorporated in and forming part of the central bank system would be four State banks in Kenya, Tanganyika, Uganda and Zanzibar, which would be allowed a certain measure of independence and freedom of decision on a territorial basis, and which would serve to safeguard the special interests of their own countries.

The report emphasizes that the distribution of functions between central bank and State banks would depend on close cooperation under a board of directors.

**Agreement**

In addition to the general principle of the independence of the banks, who would be members of the board would form a central bank, which would be controlled by the four Governments.

Such a system would give enough flexibility to conform to the needs of the territories, and to some extent political and economic development.



It followed talks in Uganda between the Minister of Internal Affairs, Mr. Omasa, and the Tanganyika Minister of External Affairs and Defence, Mr. Kamukama.

Meanwhile, the Uganda and Tanganyika Ministers are preparing proposals for a mutual assistance agreement between their countries, under which the Uganda Rifles could, if necessary, be reinforced by elements of the Tanganyika Rifles and vice versa.
