## SOMALIA STARTS SUMMIT NOW

### Let F.I. vote on future President

**ANGRY** words disrupted the African Heads of State conference in Addis Ababa yesterday when the Somali President, Mr. Aden Aden, accused Ethiopia, Britain and France of annexing Somali territory in the 19th century.

The cordial, friendly atmosphere between the African leaders which had so far characterized the conference was suddenly replaced by tension as President Aden demanded that the Somali people be asked to vote on the future of their country.

Empress Haile Selassie, the host to the conference and its president, became visibly agitated as the Somali speech proceeded. Immediately the Somali leader demanded the rights of reality and character. President Aden's speech as "an unimaginable attack" on his country.

President Aden made his call for Somali self-determination by declaring that 1,500,000 Somalis were living under foreign rule in Kenya, French Somaliland and Ethiopia. Somalia did not subscribe to the view that problems between the states should not be dealt with. It would require a lack of courage to settle African problems and would show short-sightedness.

# UNIVERSITY NAME IN MATURE SCHEME

The scheme is intended for persons of 20 years of age and above, and it is a requirement that the four-year programme should have been completed by the time of admission. There originally were 100 places, but the scheme was expanded with public interest and the number of inquiries were received in the admission office at Kampala.

Following a preliminary examination, 42 candidates were selected for admission to the first year of the university. A number of these candidates were women, and the admission office is expected to receive a number of inquiries from women who wish to do postgraduate work in the university.

## Continental assembly to meet yearly

### Elections — all over bar the counting

African charter of unity and a series of decisions to aid African liberation movements' will, volunteers and money ended a summit meeting in Addis Ababa yesterday. The charter of unity signed the 'All African Charter' setting up a body to meet once a year and a permanent secretariat, and to settle all differences peacefully among themselves. It set up an 'Organization of African Unity' for the entire continent.

The packed, circular Africa Hall, the scene for four days of busy speeches calling for unity and the total elimination of colonialism, erupted in cheers and applause during the closing scenes as the delegates agreed upon the 'Faith for the future'.

Only two leaders of independent African states were present — President Gamal Abdel Nasser of Egypt and King Hassan II of Morocco. Some African countries opposed admission of a 'Top' delegation following the assassination earlier this year. The Congo, Senegal and Nigeria would not meet with the conference because they were represented — because Mauritania, which Morocco claims, sent a delegation.

Emperor Haile Selassie, whose country is guardian of the charter, had to the conference, but the delegates: The spirit of understanding and dedication to the cause of African unity which you have shown has given me an added faith in the future.

Delegates earlier agreed to government to government to break of diplomatic relations with South Africa. The charter also called for the formation of a 'Continental Council' to coordinate the work of the member states. It also called for the formation of a 'Continental Court' to settle disputes between member states.

**Plea to U.N.**

The Heads of State decided to appeal to the United Nations to help each of their countries to end colonialism and apartheid. The resolution also included the African peoples' demand for the immediate withdrawal of the United Kingdom, France, Belgium and Portugal from their African territories and to transfer the responsibility for the territories to the African peoples.

The committee to coordinate the work of the member states will meet in Addis Ababa in the near future.





## Africans unite to end colonialism

An African charter of unity and a series of decisions by the "African national summit meeting" in Addis Ababa yesterday. Thirty Heads of State signed the "African Charter" setting up a common standard to meet a year and a permanent secretariat, and decided to settle all differences peacefully among themselves. The charter set up an "Organisation of African Unity" for the entire continent.

The packed meeting in Addis Ababa ended yesterday with the signing of the charter for unity and elimination of colonialism, erupted in cheers as the documents were signed. Only two, those of Independent African States were missing—President Kwame Nkrumah of Ghana and King Haile Selassie of Ethiopia following the assassination of President Olympio while King Haile Selassie personally presided over the conference because Mauritania, which Morocco claims, sent a delegation.

Mr. J. M. Njiru, whose country is guardian of the charter as host to the conference, told the delegates: "The spirit of understanding and dedication to the cause of African unity which you have shown has given us all faith in the future."

### Pea to U.N.

The Heads of State decided to promote a volunteer force of African national liberation fighters to liberate Africa from colonialism.

The resolution also pledged an invitation to colonial powers to regard it as a historic opportunity to bring their rule to an end peacefully in Africa.

The resolutions issued by the meeting included the decision to set up the African Charter of Unity and the Organisation of African States (O.A.S.). 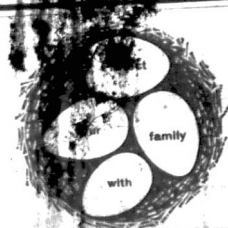

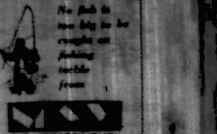

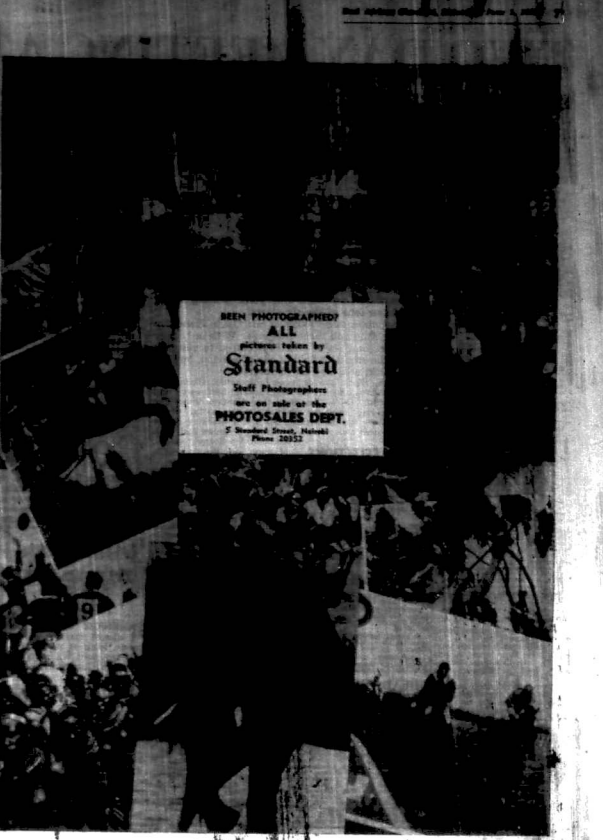
