Chief Justice Resigns And Politics RESULT OF FRICTION IN FRENCH ASSEMBLY

Political Crisis Precipitated

GENERAL Charles De Gaulle, famous wartime leader of France and head of the De Gaulle Government formed after a landslide last October, has resigned his post and announced his intention of withdrawing from political life.

There is surprise and consternation in France over the General's action.

This development follows the resignation of the minister of the interior, when the Left Wing party and majority group in the Constituent Assembly. The Communist leaders recently stated their preference for a two-party system.

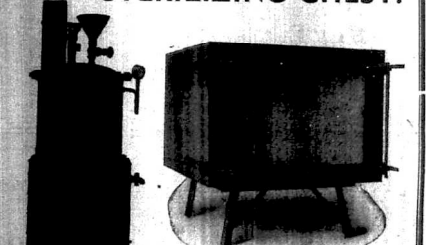

FRENCH CRISIS

General Charles de Gaulle has stepped from political life. It is impossible that he will return to office on the strength of the present situation. He has served his country magnificently in five years of office during which he has brought the "uncrowned king" of France, but with return of peace, the French have returned also to the traditional methods of approach to their political differences. He is not prepared to bargain and negotiate, for he is not ready to accommodate his principles and alignments. He prefers to get out. We have long seen a disposition on the part of the French to the fact that the qualities required for leadership in times of emergency are not those which are acceptable by the name of statesmanship in peace, or can be adjusted to the conditions of a free society. 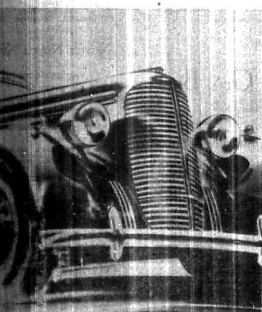

ELECTORS' UNION CONFERENCE
 The Annual Conference of the Electoral Union opens in Nairobi this morning when delegates are expected to be present from all parts of Kenya. It is also hoped that representatives from Tanganyika will be able to attend and we hope take part in the discussion especially regarding the Presidential proposal. It is a fair statement of the position to say that this week's Conference is the largest ever held in Kenya. The new Electoral Union Organisation, should it succeed in correctly interpreting public opinion and particularly in bringing back into the hands of the people the political control and initiative they have lost since the heyday of the Convention of Associations, it will be rewarded with the measure of public approval and respect. Should it fail the Country will not be far from the same position as it is at the moment. There is no time for failure.

When this year began the East African Standard published particular stress on the importance in the minds of all effective leadership of high and dependable leadership. We have seen fear of favour, leadership unbacked by popularity or unopportunity, and particularly in the case of the Government, failed the country in meeting the challenge. We have seen leadership without leadership, leadership without settlement. The events of recent weeks have caused us to change that view. On the contrary, we believe that the principal functions of this week's Conference will be to give to those on whom duties of leadership which codification has hitherto placed, the opportunity to remain satisfied with a position in which eleven individuals, nominally divided, occupy the place of the expert led, closely coordinated team which has settled in Kenya needs and might have if the strength of its political resources are to be properly used.

There is material enough, however, to suggest that the Paper is still the leading issue. There is every reason to expect a general meeting of opposition in its acceptable proposal. "LAND AT WAR"

BEFORE World War II, Britain depended on an export of wheat for 60 per cent of her food. When war broke out, and for it continued for a long time, there was grave danger that this supply would be cut off.

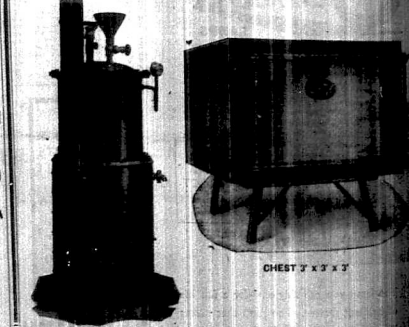

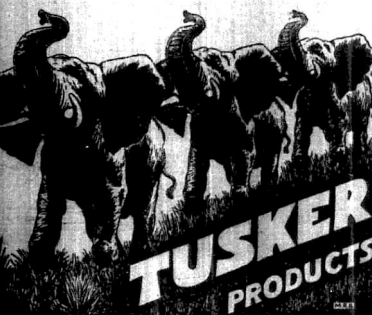

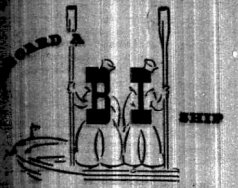
