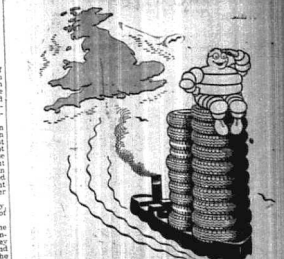

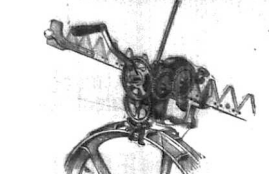

London, May 2. The British Prime Minister, Mr. Clement Attlee, declaring that the execution of the report of the Anglo-American Committee on Palestine would entail very heavy commitments, said the Commons yesterday that the British Government would support a share in the resulting additional military and financial responsibilities.

Mr. Attlee said it was clear from the facts presented in the preceding legal advice in Palestine that it would not be possible for the Government of Palestine to admit 100,000 Jews and that these formations had been disbanded and their arms surrendered.

Mr. Attlee said: "The British Government is not prepared to assume the responsibility for the care and maintenance of the Jewish population of the report. They will continue to provide for a suitable standard of living in the addition of the Palestine and of Jews in the area which they have to care for."

The British Government received the report of the Anglo-American Committee on Palestine on May 1. The report was a long and detailed document which set out the views of the Government of Palestine and of the Jewish and Arab communities in the area.
