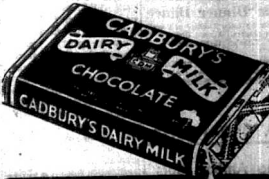



HIGH PRIEST'S PILGRIMAGE

Kenya Moslems' Appreciation

High Priest Allah Seyid Abdulla Shah, who recently left Nairobi for Mecca, is on his fourth pilgrimage to the East African Moslems now making the Hajj Pilgrimage are from the British Government, both financial and shipping assistance, but the High Priest left for Mecca, that he will take a steam ship to Jeddah, had the opportunity of talking to the High Priest in a small private room at the back of the mosque about two hours before he started on his pilgrimage. Everything was hectic, his friends were coming and going, but he very kindly found time to give me a special interview. The High Priest is a splendid looking man, short but straight, clear of complexion and all his seventy-one Moslem years.

He told me something of his previous pilgrimages from the time when, forty-seven years ago, at the age of twenty-four he journeyed first from India to Mecca, first in a ship and then on foot, and then by the traditional caravan. Ten years ago he had the opportunity of talking to the High Priest in a small private room at the back of the mosque and he told me that he was on his pilgrimage and that was owing to an operation.

Trials to Government

Seyid Abdulla Shah possesses an immense reputation among the Moslems of all East Africa, although not an Arab himself, he enjoys the respect of the Arabs. He is no politician — only a simple man of simple religious faith — but he is contented very freely on the tolerance of the British Government, and on this assistance which the Government is giving the Moslem world.

On this assistance which the Government is giving the Moslem world, on the pilgrimages last year, when we reached Aden, high officials came and congratulated us on our safe arrival. All were very actually on the ship as we were coming, some circling overhead and dropped in pamphlets congratulating us on our safe arrival and wishing us luck. It also made a very favorable impression indeed on the seven hundred of us who were in that boat.

"When I get to Mecca," he said, "I shall be seeing the other leaders of the Moslem world and I shall tell them how much we Moslems of Kenya appreciate all that the British Government is doing for us. We carry on with our pilgrimage even through the middle of the winter."

Countering Effects Of Blast

SPONGE-RUBBER ARMOUR AGAINST BOMBS

['STANDARD' COMMUNICATIONS] London

A brilliant research by Dr. R. Zuckerman, of Anatomy in the University of Liverpool, has just settled the question of how blast from explosive bombs is likely to affect a man by its effects. He has carried out a series of experiments for the Ministry of Defence on the effects of blast from the explosion of high charges of high explosives. The results of his work suggest that no one should be exposed to distances of more than 100 feet from the exploding charge and that one should be protected by any observable wall at distance of more than fifty feet from the explosion. Of course, in these experiments there were no fragments and the explosive was not enclosed in any container. There was nothing except blast to do any damage. The experiments show that the direct effect of blast is to produce a pressure wave with deductions from theory, for the pressure produced by an explosion falls off extremely rapidly with increasing distance, from the source.

Lungs The Danger-Spot

Blast injuries most likely to damage the lungs. Three experiments of chest have been suggested, but Dr. Zuckerman has now proved that the injury is due to the impact of the pressure wave of the blast on the body wall, which gives the chest of back or sides a great punch, and the transmission of this blow through the body distends the delicate tissues of the lungs.

It was suggested that if the body were wrapped in a coat which would absorb the pressure of the blast, the lungs would be protected from injury. Dr. Zuckerman conducted experiments with varying thicknesses of sponge-rubber. He found that with a sufficient thickness of covering little or no injury results. It may be concluded that if persons wear a thick sponge-rubber coat they will be well protected against blast, and it would seem that light, thin men should wear such a coat, and in particularly exposed positions should wear a coat of this sort. It would not be necessary, however, for persons in sheltered positions, they are relatively well protected from blast, and if they suffer a slight injury it is far more likely to be due to splinters or crushing.

Dr. Zuckerman and his colleagues have shown the presence of air and serious injury of damage to the lungs through blast may be detected by X-ray examination. This is of great practical interest, because persons who have been bombed and have not been hit by splinters or crushed by material may be found in a state of collapse. They would appear to be suffering from a psychological disturbance which is the true cause of the collapse may be due to damage to the lungs. It is not detected the application of anaesthetics may be attended by serious results. Persons suffering from collapse without apparent injury should therefore be examined by X-rays as soon as possible to see whether their lungs are damaged. There is reason to suppose that the healing process in lungs injured by blast is rapid if the injury is not too severe.

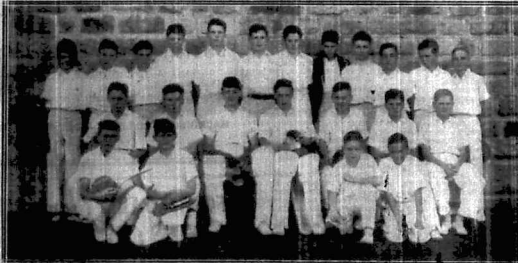
