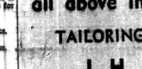

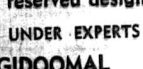

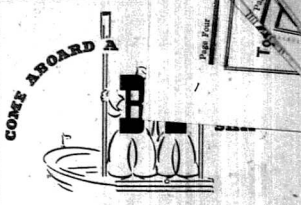

The East African Standard has always advised that as between East Africa and the Congo Belge there should be a policy, which was not only good neighbourliness in its essence but was so comprehensive and so practically generous that for all practical purposes our friends in the Congo became in all matters of present day common concern. The British family in Africa. That conception, which is the only one that will meet the needs and the spirit of today, embraces every economic, financial, political and social problem that, adequately solved, will bring added strength to our joint undertaking. POINTS FROM ANNUAL DEPARTMENTAL REPORT

Good Work by Private Schools

Kenya Education Department's annual report for 1939 was recently issued in combined form, owing to the need for economy. It may be noted that this is the first year of Mr. A. T. Lucy, as Director of Education in Kenya. Formerly in a similar post in Nyasaland, he did not assume office until March, 1939, and after a brief absence he was seconded for nearly four months to the Kenya Education Office.

The following items are quoted from the report:

PRIMARY EDUCATION
Tarapur.
The pressure on boarding accommodation, particularly in the vicinity of Nairobi, Mbaraki, Kitale, Grogmore and other areas. Towards the end of the year provision was made to add a new wing to the Kitale School. This will meet immediate needs only. The schools in Nairobi and Nairobi had to refuse requests for admission.

In Nairobi, the pressure on classroom accommodation was so great that it was decided to provide for the use of the very maximum possible buildings within the school grounds this year. Six buildings were used, some of which were not originally intended for school use, but which were used for the purpose of providing for the extra pupils. The school authorities are now endeavouring to obtain more land for the purpose of building more school buildings, but this is not yet possible.

The Education Department of Tanganyika Territory has continued to extend its facilities for the reception of children from Kenya. This course is particularly valuable for children between the ages of five and seven for whom accommodation is not available in Government schools.

There were 65 gypsies on duty during the year, an increase of five over the previous year. Of these 13 were employed in the Government schools.

Very little progress has been made in this direction, however, as it is necessary to have a sufficient knowledge of Arabic to obtain facilities for the study of Arabic in the Government schools. 



First Land Air Moves Threatening Tokruk

(Continued from page 1)

came in the announcement that 71-plot had again been raided by the Royal Air Force. Although Tokruk is 500 miles from Nairobi, it is the main base for the Italian in Libya. It is the port nearest to half the largest towns and, according to some reports, is the only place where the Italian stocks are accumulated.

Extensive Damage
It was very heavily raided as a preliminary step to the British offensive a month ago and these raids have been repeated at intervals at each important stage in the campaign. In the latest and most extensive raid by the Royal Air Force yesterday several tons of bombs were dropped. The targets included the power station, Customs buildings five wharves and shipping in the harbour. This in the harbour was straddled by our bombs; all storage was hit, including the main oil tank. The five wharves and their occupiers and large oil tank were also hit. The power station and the Customs buildings.

The fortifications of Tokruk have recently been strengthened and consist of two strong lines right round the fort. The first line is the best and best between Tunisia and Egypt.

British planes destroyed 10 Italian planes with the loss of two in the four days from January 2 to last Sunday, and on Sunday destroyed another 11.

Flies Attack at Bardia
The full story of the brilliant attack on Bardia has still to be told, but incidents are being revealed one by one. For example, British sailors who played a more important part than was at first known, have now returned to their base in Egypt and have told the story.

These warships in particular shared the battle honours. They were the Monitor, Terror, of 2,000 tons, which was used in the last week and the German during their occupation of Benghazi, and the Larkspur and Adria, which were withdrawn to the harbour in the week of the attack.

The Terror alone threw 300 tons of shells into Bardia from her 15-inch guns. The Monitor, which was used to attack motor transport, under the command of the British, was smaller craft, the British, and was hampered away with their guns.

The Italian navy very weakly at their disposal to try to beat off the attack. The Monitor, which was fired on the warships, Italian aircraft were used but all the attacks were repulsed. The British were hit. The only casualties were caused by a shell bursting near the Adria.

A naval authority in London stated that one of the most remarkable things about the Fleet's bombardment of Bardia, was that there were never any hits in any way by the Italian ships. 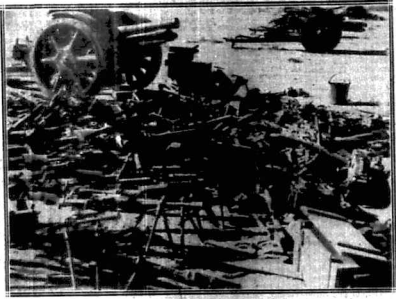

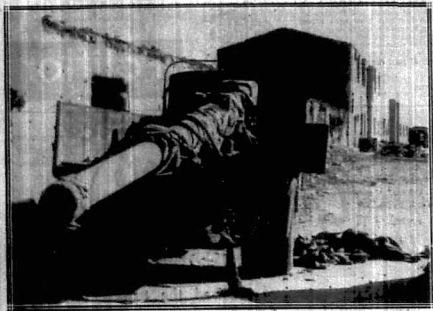

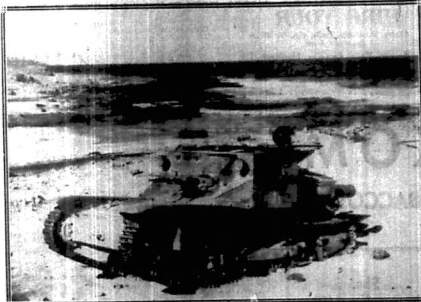

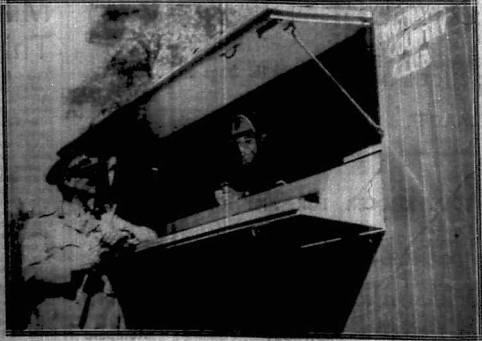
