









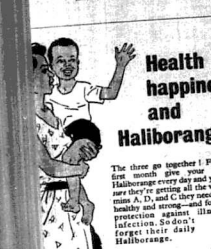

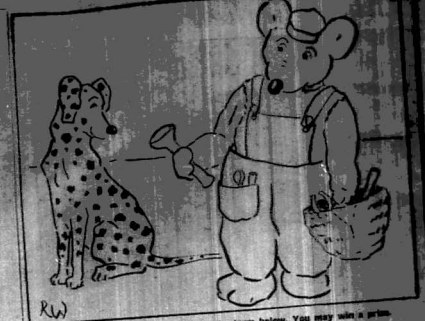

Kenya's Minister for Finance, Mr. Gichuru, told the Legislative Council yesterday that the Budget had been prepared against a background of formidable problems the country would have to face on independence, and that it was a long way towards meeting them.

### END WALK OUT PLEA TO UGANDA RULERS

FROM ANGLIO RAFAEL, STANDARD STAFF REPORTER, LONDON.

THE Colonial Secretary, Mr. Mansfield, yesterday urged the three Western Uganda rulers to return to the conference table at Marlborough House in London.

Earlier, their delegations, together with that of Ruwaga district, had walked out of Uganda's constitutional talks. They claimed that the agreement which British officials wanted them to sign was "a mutilation of the federal status promised to them under Uganda's independence constitution."

Although the Central Government delegates did not seem unduly disturbed yesterday by the boycott, some anxiety was felt on whether the conference would be able to maintain its tight schedule which is aimed at achieving independence on the original target date of October 4. A spokesman for the kingdome warned, "The delegations have no intention of going back into the conference unless they get a new agreement on their terms."

The Chief Ministers of Ruwaga, Toro and Usoga districts, in a letter to Mr. Mansfield, said they were "not prepared to accept the terms of the agreement proposed by the Government of Uganda. Sir Walter Fisher, and the kingdome delegates attending to the original target date of October 4. A spokesman for the kingdome warned, "The delegations have no intention of going back into the conference unless they get a new agreement on their terms."

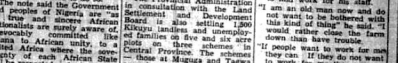

# WEEK-END TRADERS ON FEET

**BIGGEST single factor** in helping Africans to help themselves is likely to be the financial assistance schemes operated by the Ministry of Commerce and Industry. Commonly known throughout the country as the "Loans to Traders Scheme".

And few alternatives remain a means of increasing earnings, except through the sale of their own produce. While the scheme was first started in the most heavily populated parts of the country, it now operates in such major areas, where cash business are still subsisting of a variety and the old-fashioned barter system is still favoured by the older generation.

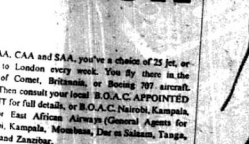

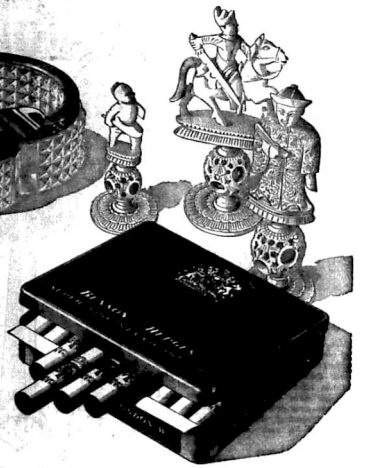

Because the Army needs such a variety of skilled men, the channels of entry and training are equally varied.

There are, for instance, the Apprentices Schools where youngsters are housed, clothed, fed and paid while they learn a first-class trade — everything from vehicle fitter to instrument mechanic. Youngsters are trained at these schools and at Junior Leader units get away to a flying start on an Army career.

There are cadets mastering the intricacies of science at lovely Welbeck Abbey. Others are enjoying what amounts to a university education at Sandhurst, while other tough, fit young men are going through a parachutist's rugged training.

At the end of all this training you find soldiers piloting aeroplanes and soldiers dealing with the complexities of guided missiles. Soldiers build bridges and make roads. Soldiers these days operate electronic computers.

And the great advantage of doing this in the Army is that the soldier-specialist works in all kinds of places from Oslo to Hongkong and from Paris to Penang.

He may be a radio man on Christmas Island or commanding a tank in Berlin. Off duty he may be skiing in Austria or sunbathing in Spain. If you want a life with some zip to it; if you've got the sense of adventure, it's odds on that whatever man's job you want to do, you can do it, better in the modern British Army.

Prospects are good, pay is good and the field is wide.

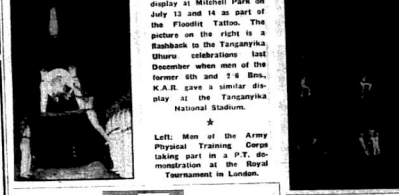

magic of bygone Kenya

IN these uneasy days of political and economic unrest it is with a feeling of almost gratitude and wishfulness that one picks up a beautiful and unexplicated book about the life that was. Such a book is Elizabeth Huxley's The Mottled Lizard.

The Kenya she is writing about is that of the years immediately after the First World War and as usual in a place that is far, far different from the Kenya of today. But the physical aspects of the land have not changed much, and reading of the life then and comparing it with the life today, one has a sneaking envy of Mrs. Huxley for having enjoyed those strange country days of her fine years.

IN THE Mottled Lizard, if it may be said of a massive undated statement, is an extremely well-written and well-illustrated book about the life she led.

Whether or not people are conscious of Kenya's climate and whether they seek to political meddling or not to support their arguments about the country is quite beside the point.

FOR the past three years or so, the Saturday Evening has kept readers of the East African Standard laughing, wherever the current crisis in the country, and often laughing at themselves in spite of everything.

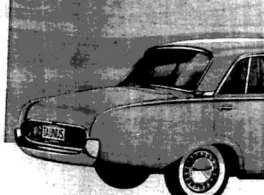
