Modern machinery doubles output from the farms

ATOM WAR ON PESTS

AUSTRALIAN scientists have developed new chemicals to control agricultural pests as a result of experiments in a new radiation laboratory in the State of Victoria.

The radiation laboratory is a spin-off of the Atomic Energy Commission's work on the use of atomic energy for peaceful purposes.

The Government has permanently housed in a special steel building the laboratory in which the new chemicals are being developed.

In general radiation will be used to sterilize the eggs of insects, thus preventing their reproduction.

Research scientists from Australian universities and the Australian Government will also use the research centre.

FAST progress from a modest beginning has made Australia one of the world's most highly mechanized primary industry nations. With 100,000 fewer farmers than 30 years ago, Australia now produces 50 per cent more food.

One Australian farmer today produces enough for 25 people. Thirty years ago he produced enough food for only 12 people. Farmers use 25,000 tractors today—nearly 100,000 more than ten years ago.

The agricultural implements manufacturing industry in Australia has grown into a versatile and complex activity with an overall annual output of farm machinery valued at more than £24,000,000 and tractors worth about 370 manufacturers.

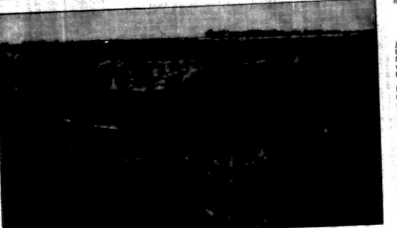

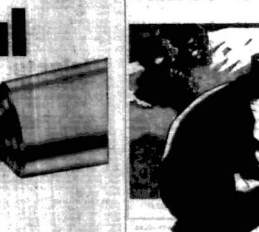

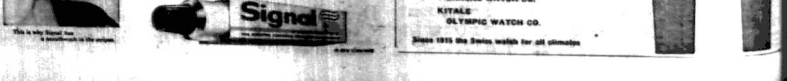

PROCESSING SOFT FRUIT

An Australian company specializing in the processing of soft fruits, including the production of fruit juices, fruit concentrates, and fruit purees, has secured a soft fruit processing licence from the Government of Kenya. The company's factory is situated in the Hunter River Valley in New South Wales and is the largest of its kind in Australia. It has a capacity of 100,000 cases of fruit per annum. The licence is valid for five years and will enable the company to export its products to Kenya and other countries in the Commonwealth. The company's products are of high quality and are second to none for quality.

OVER the years, Australian farmers and food manufacturers have demonstrated their ability to supply the people of Kenya with a variety of popular, temperate-zone foods and beverages that are high in quality yet competitive in price. In addition, Australians have gained a reputation for prompt, efficient dealings with local buyers, who are aware of the preparedness of Australian exporters to assist their merchandising of Australian products in East Africa.

This trade feature itself, as a publicity-advertising medium, is an example of the support given to local importers and distributors of Australian foodstuffs and beverages. CANNED FRUITS SENT TO MANY OTHER LANDS

AUSTRALIA has a thriving canned fruits industry. Her canned fruits and fruit juices are eaten and drunk in many countries including the East African territories, Singapore and Malaya, Ceylon, Hongkong, Thailand, Canada, West Germany, the United Kingdom and the United States.

More than 1,000,000 cases of various sizes are shipped each year in Australian containers.

Different types

Different districts are renowned for different kinds of fruit, ranging from pineapples, pawpaws and bananas in the tropical areas of Queensland to apples, peaches, pears, apricots,

oranges, lemons, nectarines and plums in the south.

The story of the canning industry in Australia is a story of wealth from irrigation areas of wealth from irrigation areas which employ only 15 per cent of the nation's work force but which account for a third of agricultural productivity.

As the waters of the River Murray provide irrigation for the dried fruits industry, so do the waters of the Murrumbidgee, the Murrumbidgee, the New South Wales, and the Goulburn in Victoria, provide irrigation for the raw material of soft fruit canning plants.

One of these suburbs, the Murrumbidgee Irrigation Area, has three fruit canneries, two

fruit peeling plants, five dried fruit processing plants, 14 wineries, four rice mills and an olive oil factory.

In the past 20 years the value of M.I.A. primary production has risen from a little more than £2,000,000 a year to nearly £10,000,000 in the grape, with a grand total of £120,000,000 in that time.

Fruit and vegetable—peas and beans are among vegetables canned in Australia—are picked in the middle of the morning and, within 12 hours of harvesting, they are canned, thus retaining their high vitamin content.

Machines designed and built

in Australia produce up to 200 cans a minute with capacities from one and a half to 100 lbs. They are packed along conveyors or belts, filled, sealed, sterilized, labelled and packaged.

Steam steriliser

Among the latest machines in operation at canneries in the Hunter Valley and in the Murrumbidgee area is a hydrostatic steam steriliser which processes 220 cans a minute.

Many of the larger canneries in Australia control the growing of the fruit and vegetables they process.

This enables them to see the growth of the crop from the start to the finish. They are inspected by government supervisors who give a constant attendance to the fact that hygiene laws and production standards are strictly observed.

THE manufacture of liqueurs in Australia is a relatively recent development, but already the range of liqueurs made there for export as well as local consumption is as extensive as it is to be found elsewhere.



Distillation formulae for an industry now producing liqueurs of the highest international standard.

In particular, Tasmania, the southern island State of Australia, is especially suited for the production of liqueurs.

The most valuable of these fruit wines are made from blackberries, raspberries and cranberries, which grow mainly in the high hills of Tasmania.

Blackberries are freshly harvested and delivered to the distillery where, after long maceration, the juice is pressed and the pulp is filtered and pumped into the tanks ready for stilling into brandy.

Part of the juice may be further processed into orange or lemon liqueur, and concentrated berry juices used for other purposes.

White and macerated herry juices need further processing before they can be bottled. The juice is distilled and the spirit is then blended with other spirits to produce a smooth and palatable liqueur.

GOLD RUSH STARTED WINES INDUSTRY

CHAMPAGNE is a term which has become a synonym for fine wine in Australia, and for which Australia, as a producer, has become widely recognised overseas. In international judges at international competitions have rated Australian champagne as among the finest in the world.

One of the famous Australian champagne-making centres is the Great Western, a number in the west of Victoria. According to local wine men, the first vines were planted by two pioneers, their names said by the discovery of gold in Australia.

Planted in 1861

They planted what was later to be known as the first vineyard in 1861.

Manufacture of champagne and sparkling wine commenced where production of ordinary still wines had been completed, and is really a second generation of the industry.

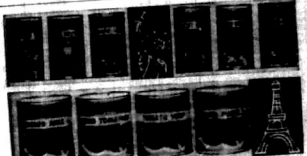

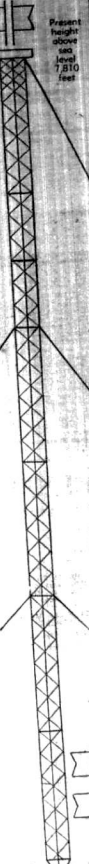

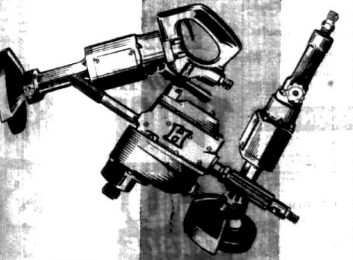
To eliminate factors—other than tyre— affecting fuel consumption, each test was made over two identical runs with a car of vehicles of the same make, model, year, etc., each vehicle alternately fitted with Michelin X tyres.
