President restates non-aligned policy

President Kenyatta, speaking at the national anniversary of the formation of the Government, restated today his determination that the country's positive non-alignment policy, which he said would be maintained as long as it was in the interest of the people, would be maintained as long as it was in the interest of the people.

President Kenyatta said that Kenya would remain firm and resolute in her declared stance of positive non-alignment. 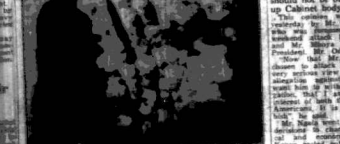

Britain shoulders task in Rhodesia

The British Prime Minister, Mr. Wilson, has told the House of Commons that it was the Government's duty to seek a democratic Rhodesia which could form the basis of independence for Rhodesia.

Replying to debates on the Commonwealth, he said it had been necessary to make "some pretty tough statements", but he thought those had been understood and supported throughout the House and had some effect.

"While the problem is a tremendously difficult — no one in any part of the House will underestimate that — it can be tried and seen by negotiation an arrangement which we are going forward — as an arrangement which would form the basis of independence for Rhodesia."

"This is what we are trying to do. I have very little to say about the difficulties, they are very big, but as long as those difficulties remain, there is hope in the job of all of us to try and turn that into a reality."

Patent negotiation

Earlier, the Commonwealth Secretary Mr. Butteny had said the Government believed the only possible way to reach a peaceful solution was by negotiation.

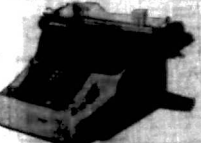

Mr. GICHURU ATTACKS CHINESE

Rules will control inflow of Red cash

Kenya's Minister for Finance, Mr. Gichuru, yesterday severely criticized the Chinese Premier, Mr. Chou En-lai, for the Senate's decision on the Foreign Exchange Control (Amendment) Bill. He told the Senators that apart from controlling the outflow of money from the country, the bill would ensure that no money entered Kenya from China or other sources without his knowledge and approval. After warning that the country's future was in jeopardy unless exchange control was introduced immediately, he said: "There are Chinese agents in this country, and the time has come for us to challenge them. They are getting money from China and the time has also come for us to control their money."

Send arms under disguise

Earlier, he told the Senate: "The other day, Mr. Chou En-lai, who has to shame, said that the whole of Africa is under a great deception but against whom, I must ask. The only thing China knows is to arm and send arms disguised through the country. Our Ambassador in Peking cannot go outside a trading firm to get arms from the house. Every time he goes out, it is disguised. The Chinese Ambassador here has built walls around his house so that he cannot be caught unawares. Mr. Gichuru said:

"He continues: "Sometimes we wonder if we should not send our Embassy in Peking to somewhere else. We can certainly use the money."

ETHIOPIA PROTESTS AT ARMS SUPPLIES

ETHIOPIA has described the reported channelling of arms from Syria, Iraq, Sudan, to Eritrean insurgents as a serious and deliberate violation of the arms embargo. A statement issued by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs said that the Government is protesting to the United Nations and the O.A.U. against the flow of arms to Eritrean insurgents. It said that the Government is determined to take all necessary steps to enforce the arms embargo and to prevent the flow of arms to the insurgents.

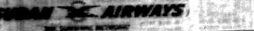
