ELVERTING HUNGARY

Deportation threat to Workers' Council GROWING TENSION

RUSSIA is reported to be moving 20 infantry divisions into Hungary. Western observers in Budapest believe it likely that these troops will replace the ten to 15 Soviet armoured divisions already committed to be in the country.

According to a source close to the Hungarian Government, the Soviet authorities said that the first of the 20 divisions had already arrived. A Russian division is estimated to number between 10,000 and 20,000 men.

The Prime Minister, Mr. Kadar, has threatened all members of the Greater Budapest Workers' Council with deportation to Russia unless the nationwide strike is ended. This was announced in leaflets distributed in the capital. The leaflets added that a number of people the council requested would be deported with them.

Anger is mounting over reports of mass arrests and deportations. A miners' delegation called on Mr. Kadar and threatened to flood the pits if the deportations did not stop.

A message from a Hungarian radio amateur picked up in Vienna said: "About 10,000 Hungarians in 18 trains were taken to Russia between November 14 and 17." There were about 200 babies among them, he added.

Sabotage threat by miners and oil men

WHILE the leaflets announcing the Hungarian Prime Minister's deportation threat to Workers' Council members were being circulated, Budapest Radio carried a Government denial of "rumours of mass arrests and deportations of young people to the Soviet Union."

The radio admitted that "some message" was slipped up in the "conference" for help after the "conference" was held. It said that some Hungarians had been taken to the Soviet Union.

It said "treason" had been committed by some 2,500 Budapest citizens who were being deported to the Soviet Union.

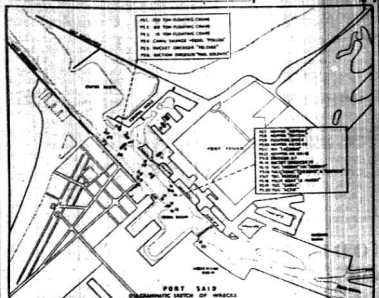

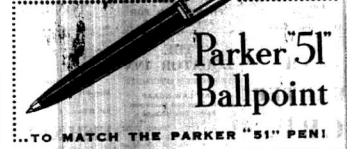

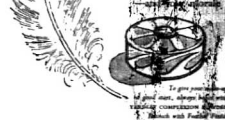

Railways and Harbours revenue drops

OCTOBER ANALYSIS

RAILWAY receipts for the first ten months of this year decreased by about 11 per cent, compared with the same period in 1954. This is largely accounted for by a fall in earnings from railway goods traffic, according to the review for October issued by the East African Railways and Harbours Administration.

Receipts from railway and harbour services in October amounted to £1,872,796, compared with £1,872,096 in the same month last year. Receipts were £207,200 below the level estimated for October.

Passenger takings Revenue for this ten months—totalled £1,288,900. This compares with £1,240,000 in the same period last year, but was £108,000 short of the estimate in the recently revised estimate for 1954.

Railway earnings for October totalled approximately £1,370,000, compared with £1,372,000 in the same month of 1954. The total revenue for the first ten months of 1955 amounted to £14,312,000, compared with £14,580,000 in the same period last year, a decrease of nearly 11 per cent. Rail goods traffic receipts amounted to £1,117,000, compared with £1,413,000 last year.

Mombasa Islands Overall earnings from passenger services showed a slight increase, but total revenue from £1,212,000 in the same period of 1954 to £1,288,900 in the same period of 1955. 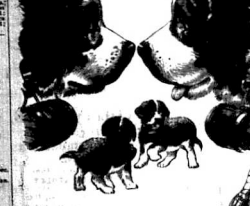

FEARS ON FUTURE OF BEEF OUTPUT

Possibility of imports stressed

UNLESS beef production increased substantially Kenya is likely to become a meat importing country. This is the view of Mr. C. Neville, a British farming expert, who on behalf of the Minister for Agriculture. He states in his report that there is no need to import beef from outside Africa.

His report states that in the next three years this country will be hard pressed to meet the requirements of its own population and a limited export surplus is likely to be the best that the Kenyan Government can expect.

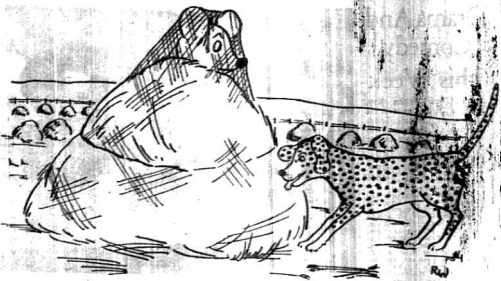

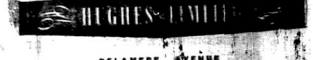

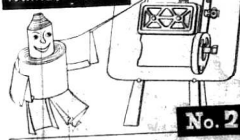
