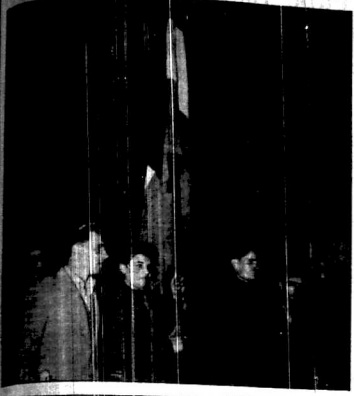


Freedom flag flies in London

He then detailed his five-point proposal for a common Anglo-American policy on the Middle East. Two of these points were the prevention of further hostilities between Israel and the Arab States, and the restoration of a permanent system for the Suez Canal in accordance with the six principles adopted by the Security Council.

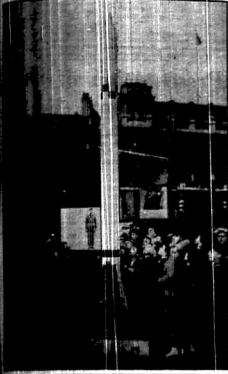
