10-MILE ISRAEL PIPELINE TO BY-PASS THE SUEZ CANAL

Work on project begins in next few weeks

18-MONTH COMPLETION



ISRAEL will begin building a pipeline from the Gulf of Aqaba to the Mediterranean within a few weeks. This was disclosed by the French Foreign Minister, M. Pinerau, in a press conference yesterday. The proposed pipeline, which would be 10 miles long, would bypass the Suez Canal for its oil and it is believed that Arab oil will be selected as the Mediterranean terminal.

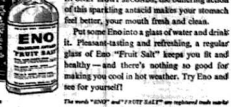

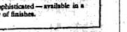

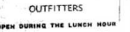

ROADS UPKEEP DELAYS NEW TARMAC WORK

This was stated by the chairman of the Roads Committee, Chas. Mason, in replying to a question in Parliament in Nairobi yesterday.

Mason explained that parts of the delay in getting the new tarmac road work started was due to the fact that plans and specifications for the different types of roads were still awaiting the Council's approval.

Mason also mentioned that the Council had decided to postpone the purchase of a new road roller until next year.

Commons discuss anti-American feeling in Britain

ASSURANCE ON AIR BASES

SIR ANTHONY EDEN gave an assurance in the House of Commons that military bases would continue to be available in Britain for American forces. The Prime Minister in confident and cheerful mood, replied to questions over relations with the United States since the Suez crisis.

Sir Frank Mottison, Conservative, asked the Prime Minister for an assurance for the importance of maintaining friendly relations with the United States and that the bases would continue to be available.

He also asked for an assurance that American forces in Britain would have the same facilities as British forces, and that the Government would have the same facilities as the representatives of a great ally.

Permit refused

Some Americans in Britain have complained recently of such incidents as being refused petrol at garages and being turned out of hotels, for British indignation in the United States.

The other Conservative opposition asked for an assurance that the Government would do its utmost to prevent such incidents.

A Labour Member, Mr. Arthur Wood, asked the Prime Minister for a statement on the possibility of such incidents in the future.

Sir Anthony replied that he had suggested these would be investigated.

PREMIER RETAINS SUPPORT

Still no rival for party leadership

FOR the first time since his return from Jamaica, Sir Anthony Eden met Conservative M.P.s privately on Tuesday night.

Descriptions of the reception given the Prime Minister varied from "good" to "very good" and he was widely agreed that his speech was well received. However, the Middle East crisis was well-received. The meeting's ending was said to have been more emotional than usual.

At the conclusion of the meeting he was heard to say: "I have given views."

Gave own views

Sir Anthony gave his views on the Suez crisis to a group of Conservative M.P.s who were not present at the reception. He said that he had not acted as he did in the Middle East. He also claimed that he had not acted in favour of the Conservative Party. The Prime Minister, who argued of interest was the possibility of an alternative pipeline route through the Middle East.

Some of his supporters thought he was over-enthusiastic in his own defence. It was pointed out that his speech had contained serious criticisms of the Government's handling of the Suez crisis.

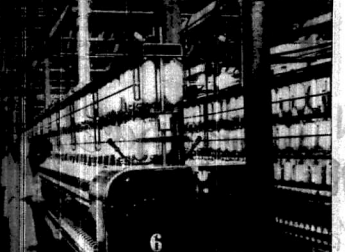

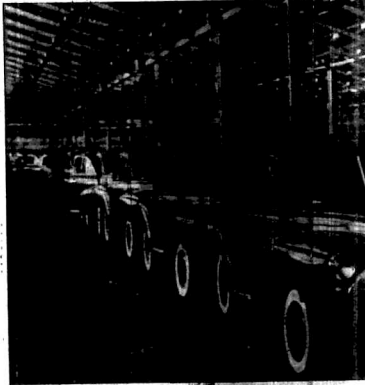

INDIAN bicycles are fast gaining popularity in the export market. Sturdy and low-priced, they meet the needs not only of India's own population, but also of a growing number of people in other countries. The bicycle is the poor man's motor. There is adequate evidence in the statistics of the country that the population of 340 million people in India has to have been imported from abroad in the last few years. After the war, the bicycle industry has been established in India rapidly, expanding both in capacity and production.

New production

Two firms came into existence with the collaboration of well-known foreign firms. Two others started production in India early. By the end of 1952, there were six units engaged in production with a total installed capacity of about 430,000 bicycles per year. Seven new schemes for the manufacture of bicycles were sanctioned by the Government in 1953 and some of the existing works were allowed to work overtime shifts as well as to expand their capacity. Besides these large factories, a large number of smaller plants are also in the field, producing mainly bicycle parts intended for replacement of the existing stock of this industry. The total capital invested amounts to Rs. 16 million, of which foreign capital accounts for Rs. 2.5 million. About 4,000 people are employed in the industry and the number is expected to rise considerably with the expansion of manufacturing going into production.

FERTILISER PRODUCTION

It has been another year of steady progress and expansion in India's State-owned fertiliser industry. The total output of ammonium sulphate produced was 539,923 tons, against 399,083 tons in the previous year. A record was set in January 1956, with a monthly production of 42,248 tons at a daily average of 1,407 tons.

Two more fertiliser factories are to be set up. Although the output goes of present capacity to meet Indian needs, some quantities may become available for export in future. Experiments are already in the stage in the use of this type of Indian fertiliser on the farms of East Africa.

The Government is promoting the industry by providing subsidies and other facilities. The area under mulberry cultivation is now three times the present 4,000 acres, and efforts have been made with some success to increase the yield of improved types of mulberry. 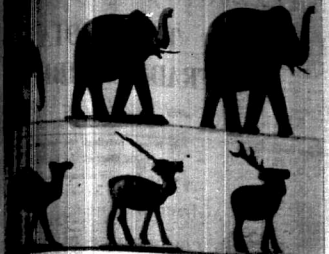

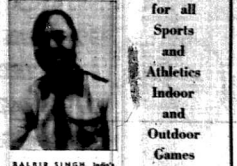

India plans to double car production by 1961

LAST year India made 9,228 motor cars and 13,560 trucks, a total of 22,808 vehicles. In 1961 she plans to produce 45,000.

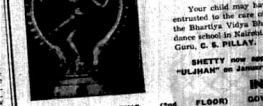

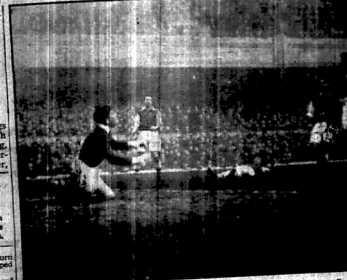

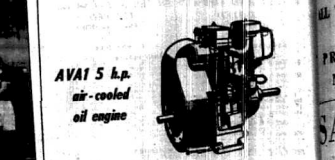

The US aid plan — formed almost entirely without British and France — was to include about £70,000,000 for each of the fiscal years starting on July 1, 1957 and July 1, 1958, and the term "Middle East" had been clarified in a speech from the State of Gibraltar to the Arabian Sea, according to US Press reports.

The aid programme would be in addition to the Administration's request for more than £250,000,000 in Congressional appropriations for assistance to the rest of the world.

The US Defense Department officials said a reinforced Marine Battalion of 1,000 men, with all necessary equipment for making a landing, was attached to the Sixth Fleet in the Mediterranean. A London dispatch from the New York Herald Tribune said the first few companies of the Sea Marines were prepared to be sent to the Gulf to assist the American troops.
