PROPOSED change in Crown titles

SEPARATE LANDS WITH BUGANDA GOVERNMENT

The proposals would leave the Protectorate Government in the Eastern, Western and Northern Provinces of Uganda and for introducing individual land titles in these areas to encourage land ownership by Africans were announced yesterday by the Uganda Government.

The proposals would leave the Protectorate Government and local authorities with powers to acquire land compulsorily for public purposes, but would not allow such acquisitions for economic purposes.

Crown land in Buganda is excluded from the measures, but under new Buganda agreement, discussions are to be held between the Governor of Uganda, Sir Andrew Cohen, and the Kabaka Government on possible modifications in the status of land vested in the Crown under the Buganda agreement.

Discussions on the proposals are to be held in all districts and the Minister of Lands, Mr. Mungoyi, will hold talks with local representatives during the next 12 months.

HOLIDAYS IN EAST AFRICA

To The Seychelles And Back In Two Weeks

FIVE DAYS in the Seychelles; now, it's back to a coo-fer-dee shell and a couple of Haplozetes. Les Fleurs de Mer, I was on my way back to Nairobi and work.

As the B.I. her cabin crew signed her way past the palm-bordered shores of North Point, I remembered myself with the thought that one day I would go back to these enchanting islands for its food and that whenever the breeze took to reliving "the beauty of the islands" — the main islands of the archipelago — that last five days in a sail, begotten part of France — a France where the tempo of life was that of an age long past; where a background of isolation and remoteness bequeathed perfect beauty, tranquillity and an unworldly tranquillity that had been known to the ancients.

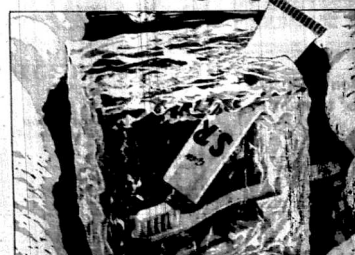

THIRTY YEARS OF AVIATION IN KENYA COLONY

It has been said by many enthusiasts that the Kenya Air Show at Kitale is the logical culmination of the 30 years of the development in aviation. Appropriately therefore, the Show will give to a mixture of both old and new.

The oldest flying machine in the world will be the first to be imported into the Colony known by its registration number VPXAA which aircraft is a D.E. Series 51 built by the De Havilland Aircraft Company at Hatfield in 1925 and imported to Kenya in 1926 by Mr. John Carter of Nairobi. The nearest will be the U.S.A. latest type Vesuvius fighters.

Back in 1928

BETWEEN the entry into the Colony of these two aeroplanes a great deal has happened in aviation in East Africa. It was on September 10, 1928, that VPXAA, then owned by Skinner and A. Hughes, of Nairobi, became the first aeroplane to be registered in Kenya, being named "Hiss Kenya".

Kenya's entry into the Colony, and a subsequent visit to East Africa in 1927 by a Royal Air Force Flight, created a great deal of interest.

Flight three ex-Air Force officers demonstrated the promotion of aviation and formed an ex-Service Association which, owing to great public interest, quickly became an Aero Club open to the general public.

Quickly extending its activities to neighbouring territories, the Club became the Aero Club of East Africa under the patronage of the Governor and all the territories, the British Resident of East Africa and the High Commissioner for the Sudan.

War Service

ATTACHED to the Royal Aero Club of the United Kingdom, the East Africa Club had 507 members by the end of 1939. At an early date the club treated the importance of building up potential reserves of trained flying personnel to cater for a possible emergency in Africa and in 1937 it inaugurated "A" Licences.

It has submitted partly by the Government, the club trained many pilots in R.A.F. preparatory standards and on the outbreak of war all those members who had undertaken to serve were volunteered under the command of an officer trained in East Africa from quality in the R.A.F. East Africa.

The R.A.F. East Africa was employed in this service. The 700 hours R.A.A.F. was employed in training and Air Communication in addition.

Many of these pilots were carried out in single-engine aircraft, without safety appliances, many miles out to sea. The last one became absorbed into the R.A.F. and lost its identity.

Training

USING its two Tiger Moths, two Chipmunks and two Tiger Cruiser aircraft, the Club has trained many enthusiasts. In training, many of these pilots increased their flying hours by carrying out a job as a pilot was required after obtaining his qualifications and one to ten hours flying time.

Last year was introduced a regulation necessary to obtain a "Private Pilot's Licence" for which the qualification is 40 hours flying time, including 15 hours solo.

By subsidising flying time, the club keeps the cost for a complete course for one of its members down to about £110. It would cost £200 or £250 to qualify for a "P" Licence.

Such a course would probably cost £250 to £300 if it were not for the subsidy, and in view of the fact that it is to be derived in East Africa from quality in the R.A.F. East Africa, it is not surprising that an increase in the number of inquiries is being received.

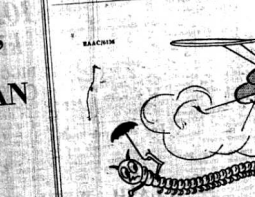

WHITE PAPER TABLED ON COURTS REPORT

Government proposals for a limited qualified franchise for Africans based on education, experience, public service and character, coupled with a system of multiple voting, were published yesterday in a White Paper on the Courts Report.

Both documents were tabled at a specially convened meeting of Kenya Legislative Council. The debate on the proposals is expected to take place in the House of the Council which begins next week.

Acceptance of the recommendation of Mr. W. F. Coates, recently appointed Minister for Education and Labour and Trade, will mean that the Government will be asked to adopt for all African elections. The Government has said that it will be introduced into Kenya in February to investigate the possibility of introducing a system of multiple voting for the Legislative Council, based in mind the difference that may exist between various races, and to draw up any drafts that may be necessary.

Multiple voting, which would allow a voter to vote for more than one candidate, was suggested by Mr. Coates in his report. The Government intends to introduce the Courts Report by getting a syllabus of the proposed system, and to retain the essential principle of the system, which would be sufficient of the system.
