

**TRUP COMMITTEE'S**  
RECOMMENDATIONS  
CONTROL of Kenya's rapidly expanding dairy industry by a statutory board on which producers would have a majority, is recommended to the Government by the Trup Committee.

The committee, which set up last year, mentions the dangers of world over-production and suggests: "It is wise to introduce statutory control of the 'milk war' really starts and entrenched interests become more difficult to disentangle, thus avoiding the bitter experience of other countries."


The proposed board would have what the committee describes as "the maximum range of powers." These would include power to fix both producer and retail prices, regulate standards and conditions of retail, and fix production quotas. The exercise of some of these powers, particularly those on price and minimum approval.

The committee hopes that the board would interfere as little as possible with existing channels and that it would try, with the good-will of all organisations, to combine the merits of an over-all control with the maximum individual freedom and initiative.

A main function of the board would be to conduct market research inside and outside Kenya so that there will be outlets for a production which is estimated will rise from 17,000,000 gallons per year to 100,000,000 gallons over the next ten years. It is recommended that the board should have the right to make and enforce rules on the scheduled sales, appointed by the Director on the recommendation of the Board of Agriculture, two members with wide experience of business, appointed by the Minister in consultation with the Milk Producers' Association, one representative of the Government, and one representative of the Veterinary Department.

The committee says that the annual value of milk to produce in Kenya is about 2,000,000 gallons, and that the industry is growing rapidly. It is estimated that the total milk production in Kenya is about 2,000,000 gallons in 1955, and that this will rise to 10,000,000 gallons in 1965. The committee believes that the rapid development in the European highlands in recent years has led to a large increase in the milk production of the region.



## CHILDREN LEFT IN CARE OF AFRICAN SERVANTS

PARENTS who left their children in the unorganized care of African servants were sharply criticised by the President of the East African Women's League, Mrs. C. B. Anderson, this week. Following her report at the annual meeting of the League, Mrs. Anderson said: "We have a problem and that is delinquent parents and not delinquent children."

She said that the newly formed Child Welfare Society had been approached by the police to reiterate the warnings often given by the League to parents leaving children, especially girls, with African servants. Last year there were six reported cases of indentured girls under the age of eight years. "In the three months of this year," said Mrs. Anderson, "there have been as many reported cases of delinquency of young children as in the whole of 1955, and there are many more not reported."

Mrs. Anderson emphasised that the problem she was pointing out was not the fault of the African servants but of the parents who left their children in their care. "The fact that many of these children have been left with servants has not been the cause of the problem," she said. 


