

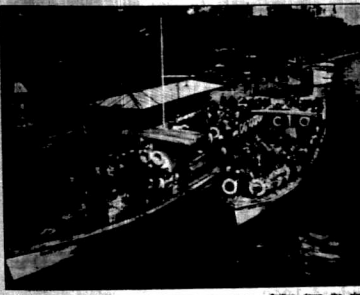

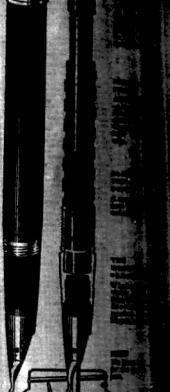

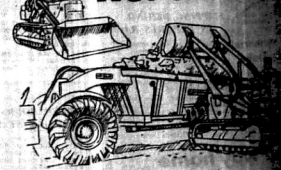

Hope of early end to rail dispute

**FIVE-POINT SETTLEMENT
DRAWN UP BY T.U.C.**

Members of the 70,000 railwaymen on strike in Nairobi last night accepted a five-point 'peace' plan to settle their wage grievance drawn up by the Trade Union Congress.

The approval of the T.U.C. plan was announced by Mr. J. M. Njiru, secretary of the Associated Society of Locomotive Engineers and Firemen, whose members are fighting for increases of their wage margins over the railwaymen. Mr. Njiru's statement came soon after T.U.C. chiefs met to discuss the Government of the progress of their efforts to end the strike.

It was proposed that the A.S.L.E.F. should state the minimum wage increase acceptable as a basis for the return of the 70,000 members. Then the question of a wage increase between the flogging men and the less skilled workers - the main point of the dispute - would be referred to a joint panel.

The A.S.L.E.F. leaders said that when the plan was approved, he would return to work in the knowledge that the railway dispute was at an end.

The plan was approved by the members of the A.S.L.E.F. and the members of the T.U.C. for their respective organizations.

SURRENDER OFFER TO BE WITHDRAWN ON JULY 10

Forfeiture of land order extension OPERATIONS CONTINUING 'AT FULL PRESSURE'

THE surrender terms offered to Mau Mau terrorists by the Governor, Sir Evelyn Baring, on January 18 will be withdrawn on July 10. Gangsters who hold out after this date will have their lands and rights in land forfeited.

Announcing this in Kenya Legislative Council yesterday, the Minister without Portfolio, Mr. Michael Blundell, said that in the intervening period 10 operations against the gang would be "at full pressure". He disclosed that since January 18 the terrorists had suffered 1489 casualties, apart from 659 surrenders—including 29 gang leaders.

Mr. Blundell, who some weeks ago said the Government would wait at least 30 days notice of its intention to withdraw the offer, said the terms would be effective until midnight on July 10, but they could be withdrawn earlier if the military situation demanded such a course.

A Government spokesman later explained that whether the "free branch" surrender terms—announced on August 12, 1953—would continue after July 10 depended on the situation at that time. A decision would be taken by the War Council and the Government on the military and operational situation on the date, he said. The 1953 terms promised that terrorists who laid down their arms and surrendered by July 10 would be allowed to return to their homes. The Government would not be bound to accept the offer if the military situation demanded such a course.

KENYA will never return to the pre-Emergency system of forest labour in which Kikuyu squatters were drafted about at a great rate to work on the Ministry of Forest Development. Mr. L. R. M. The Minister was speaking on a vote of £410,000 which was approved by a majority of 100.

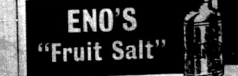

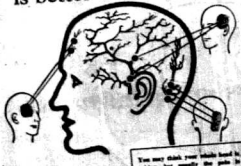

Kenya decides to take Uganda power

CHEAPER THAN MAKING OWN DEVELOPMENTS

The Kenya Government announced yesterday in a White Paper presented to the Council of Ministers, that it had decided to take the power from the Owen Falls Hydro-Electric station in Uganda. Subject to certain conditions, a licence for supplying the power has been issued to the Government.




