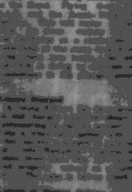

**MORE QUESTIONS ON KENYA**

(STANDARD'S CORRESPONDENT)

The Government grant for the education of African children in elementary schools in Kenya and the number of children, both European and African, attending schools were the subject of questions in the House of Commons yesterday.

Mr. Pelling asked the Secretary of State for the Colonies whether he will state the amount of grant paid to the Government for the education of African children in elementary schools each year in Kenya.

Mr. MacDonald: I assume that by "elementary schools" you mean the primary schools which are maintained by the Government. The amount of grant paid in 1935 and an estimate for 1936 is £29,700. This figure does not include the expenses of instruction and inspection.

In a further reply, Mr. MacDonald said that in 1937 12,377 African children attended Kenya elementary schools. He had no figures to show the total of African children attending elementary school age. As regards European children, the number was 1,841.

**Native Taxes**

Mr. Pelling also asked the Secretary of State for the Colonies what is the amount paid by the white-bellied Africans in direct taxes each year in Kenya?

Mr. MacDonald: The rate of direct taxation in Kenya is prescribed annually by the Government. In 1935 the normal rate was fixed at 12s. although in certain cases it was fixed at a lower rate.
