Criminals in Sulk
 Mr. Justice has nothing to do with wagers, or with the virtues of the law, or with the merits of the legal profession, at least so far as the old adage about making the punishment fit the crime. A cynic once said that the difference between a criminal and an ordinary man was that the prisoner wanted to go where he liked, did not know where he wanted to go, and was ready to accept the consequences. The successful criminal may be known by the quality of his work and the texture of his suit.

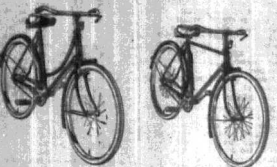

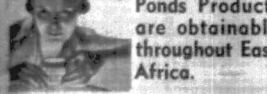

they tried to keep their own
children away and every that it

who value loyalty and see some-
thing worth preserving in tradi-
tion, bestir themselves to make
Empire Day even more notable
in this distant Colony where we

On May 24 His Majesty the
King returned from Canada a
moving Empire Day speech
which was universally regarded
as one of the most notable de-
clarations of the meaning of the
Empire ever made by a Sovereign.
It is useful to recall now
what he said because his words
are the answer to this
regrettable Kenya movement.
He said "The faith in reason
and fair play which we share
with the people of the United
States, is one of the chief ideals
guiding the British Empire to-
day. It is not in the power
wealth alone, nor in domination
over other peoples, that the true
greatness of a nation, may alone
be measured. These things are but
the instruments—peace and jus-
tice, peace and good measure for
all, secure against attack
from within and without. It is
only by adhering to the spiritual
dignity and material happiness
of human life in all its myriad
of forms that a nation can
claim to be of service to its own
people in the world." And his
young son said "I feel just as all
that to be and good measure
in the heritage which your
fathers have left to you."

It will be surprised if dis-
approval of the proposal goes further

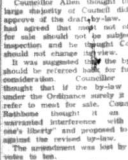

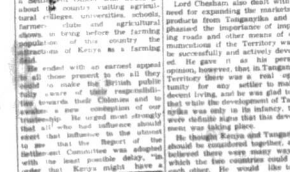

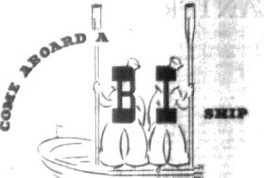
