FISH FOR UGANDA

OPERATING a modern quick freezing plant and quick storage in the Equator is just one of the many varied activities now being undertaken by Tulfarm, the Uganda Fish Marketing Corporation, which provides supplies of fresh, dry salted and smoked fish for Africans at prices which they can afford.

Until recently they were engaged in trading African karamba and trout products which were bought, wet salted and sold to the United States for dollars. The Uganda Government had a 50 per cent share in the Corporation, which was set up as a public utility corporation. The balance was held by local African businessmen and the shareholders.

Lake George, 185 square miles of water, is the main source of fish. The water flows through the entire length of the lake, which is 100 miles long. The water abounds in free swimmers, such as the Nile crocodile and large numbers of cat and lung fish. The Corporation, however, does not carry out the fishing. It is the fishermen who catch the fish and bring it to the Corporation, which then carries out the freezing and storage. The Corporation supplies these fishermen with ice and equipment at cost and so returns them well above the 50 per cent of a fish price the wet round.

WHEN Tulfarm started operations in 1950, its fishings reached the annual figure of 30 tons. In order to avoid over-fishing, the normal catch of this figure can now average over 400 per acre per month. The total monthly catch is now 1,500 tons. Ninety per cent of the fish at present being marketed are sold to the public. The remainder is either sold to the British Congo for hard currency, or to the Government for export to the Belgian Congo for hard currency.

It is hoped to switch over the majority of production to smoking and quick-freezing fish this year and so in doing this to provide a source of income for the fishermen. The Corporation is also planning to provide for African consumption in Uganda and in the surrounding areas. At present fresh fish in the Congo has to travel all the way from Kampala by air to Kisumu in Kenya. Tulfarm has now constructed its own wharf at the end of the lake in Kampala, near the fishery station, so that aircraft can fly out the bulk of Tulfarm's production.

Kampala, capital of Uganda, is over 200 miles from Lake George and twice each week a large diesel driven transport fish on ice during the cool of the night in Tulfarm's modern refrigerated display cabinet. The ship is fitted with a cold room and a refrigerated display cabinet. Over 8,000 fish are held here each week.

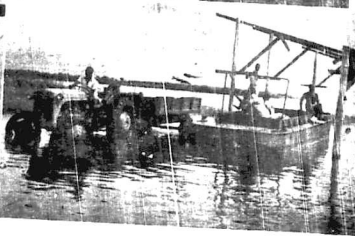
The Lake George venture is claimed to be unique in the Commonwealth. Three years ago it was a large factory area with accommodation for 500 Africans and four modern buildings for the factory staff. It was just completed. Over £227,000 was invested in the new refrigeration scheme at Lake George.

There are still more lakes, which may require attention, over the fishery station at Lake George. It is hoped to switch over to fish which are not so abundant and quick-freezing fish.

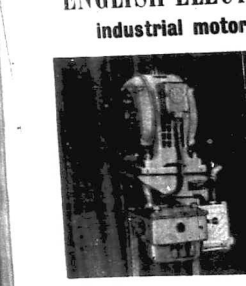
