The State of Agriculture—No. 4 MECHANISATION LAGGING BEHIND LABOUR LOSSES

By the AGRICULTURAL CORRESPONDENT

There are three farming districts in the Kenya Highlands where mechanisation has helped to bring about a swift transition in the acreages under cultivation. Since the crop most involved is wheat, it is not surprising that they should be Nakuru-Laikipia, Laikipia and the Trans-Nzoia.
