BUDGET SESSION RESUMES TODAY

Kenya's 1950 estimates NEW RULES SUGGESTED TO SPEED UP THE DEBATE

On Kenya's 1950 estimates will begin in Kenya Legislative Council on 10 a.m. today when the Kenya Government will present its budget.

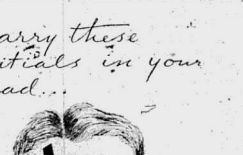
