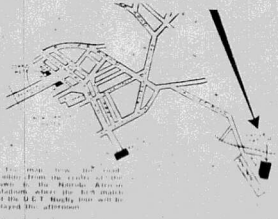


Diagram illustrating the route of the University tour.

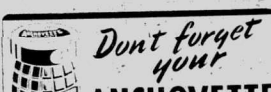
