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PROVISION OF SANITARY TOWELS TO NEEDY GIRLS IN PUBLIC PRIMARY SCHOOLS IN KENYA

Abstract

One of the goals of education is to achieve gender equity towards empowerment. This is in line with Education for All (EFA) and Millennium Development Goals (MDGs). Social cultural economic and political factors have tended to affect children especially girls' enrolment, participation and retention in school particularly in the developing countries.
