Dr. Onyonka noted that Ken-yatta University College is "pre-sently run entirely" by the Min-istry of Education, and the Min-istry could, therefore, make a decision about expulsions. But the day-to-day running of the University of Nairobi is in the hands of its own council, he observed. The Ministry only provides funds and planning for expansion, he said.
