UNIVERSITY REOPENS AFTER FIVE MONTHS

THE University of Nairobi
reopens today after a fivemonth closure.

Kenya's Minister for Education, Dr. Zachary Onyonka, announced over the weekend that all students of Kenyatta University College will be readmitted today and said the authorities were willing to sit down to find viable solutions to the students' problems.

Just before Christmas, the Registrar of the University of Nairobi, Mr. Simon Karanja, announced new regulations for the reopening of the University and lists of students eligible for readmission were published.

The new regulations make it compulsory for students to attend classes and also to obtain permission before organising demonstrations or processions.
